Dear Friends,

This is our last full week before Lent. In the gospel today, Jesus teaches that He has not come to abolish the law and the prophets, but to fulfill them. Remember when you learned the 10 Commandments?

- 1. I am the LORD your God. You shall worship the Lord your God and Him only shall you serve.
- 2. You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.
- 3. Remember to keep holy the Sabbath day.
- 4. Honor your father and your mother.
- 5. You shall not kill.
- 6. You shall not commit adultery.
- 7. You shall not steal.
- 8. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
- 9. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife.
- 10. You shall not covet your neighbor's goods.

As Catholics, we recognize that we must follow the Commandments, but Jesus expects even more from us: "You have heard that it was said to your ancestors, *you shall not kill; and whoever kills will be liable to judgment.* But I say to you, whoever is angry with his brother will be liable to judgment." As we prepare ourselves for the upcoming Lenten season, it might be good for us to review the 10 Commandments and to recommit ourselves to the deeper call that we have as disciples of Jesus. *Turn away from sin and be faithful to the gospel!*

Tuesday is Valentine's Day. I'm sure a number of parishioners will get engaged in the upcoming days, and so we pray for all young couples planning to marry, that the Lord will bless them in their desire to be faithful to one another and to grow in their love for one another for the rest of their lives. We pray, too, for those who are already married, that they may continue to be blessed in their love for one another and by their children and grandchildren. We also pray for those whose "valentines" are in heaven. May the love of God reassure them that one day we will all be reunited in the kingdom.

At this time of year, our accountant prepares recommendations for tuition for the upcoming school year. It is no surprise that the model that promoted Catholic education generations ago simply no longer exists. Congregations of religious women and men who dedicated themselves to teaching are quickly disappearing, and the costs of running a school keep going up. Our current tuition is \$6,050 per child, and we will raise the tuition to \$6,450 next year. Besides offering our faculty and staff an extremely modest salary increase, we expect the cost of benefits to rise by 7% and the cost of property insurance to go up 15%. Most of the families enrolled in our school do not worship regularly at St. Luke and so do not contribute to the parish in any significant way, and so we have no choice but to raise tuition to offset the increased costs. I was recently at an inter-religious gathering at Vickie Paladino's office and one of the rabbis present mentioned that the tuition in his school is over \$9,000. We are certainly grateful for the sacrifices parents make to send their children to St. Luke School, and we pray that we can find other sources of income to offset the ever-increasing costs of running a school.






L for Liquid Layers
