Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Friends,

As you know, this is a long weekend because of Presidents' Day, and many schools are closed for winter recess this week. I hope and pray that all those who will have a chance to get away will have an enjoyable time with family and friends. We pray in a special way for Fr. Chin as he has the opportunity to return home to spend time with his parents, family and friends and to be in Vietnam for the first time as a priest. Please remember that the rectory office will be closed on Monday for Presidents' Day, and the daily Mass will be celebrated at 9:30 AM instead of at noon.



The Saturday before Lent is the Feast of Our Lady of Trust. While the feast isn't celebrated on the General Calendar of the Church, Pope St. John Paul II began the papal custom of venerating the image of Our Lady of Trust at the Roman Seminary at St. John Lateran in preparation for the season of Lent. In the image, Mary is holding the Child Jesus, who is pointing to his mother's Immaculate Heart. It is believed that Our Lady of Trust protected the Roman seminarians from the Asiatic flu in 1837, and in thanksgiving the

seminarians crowned the image of Mary and Jesus. I have spoken of my relationship with the Pro Sanctity Movement and the Apostolic Oblates in the past. Their founder, Bishop Giaquinta, developed a devotion to Our Lady of Trust when he was in the seminary, and she is a special patroness for the Movement and the community. As we begin our Lenten journey here at St. Luke, may we rely on the special intercession of Mary to accompany us through the forty days. *Our Lady of Trust, pray for us!*

Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, a day of fast and abstinence. Please see this bulletin for more information regarding the discipline of Lent, as well as the programs and devotions that will take place here at St. Luke. We have placed the Ash Wednesday schedule on the cover of the bulletin for your convenience. Ashes will be distributed at 10:30 AM during a prayer service, at the Noon Mass, during a prayer service at 3:00 PM and at Mass at 7:30 PM. Lent is an important time every year for the faithful to renew their relationship with the Lord Jesus. As the ashes are imposed on our foreheads, we are told to, "Repent and believe in the Gospel." Hopefully Lent lasts longer than the ashes remain on our foreheads! Let us recommit ourselves to the Lord through prayer, fasting and almsgiving, that through our works of charity we may experience the mercy of God and follow the Light of Christ throughout our lives.

Because Ash Wednesday falls on February 22nd this year, we miss out on the opportunity to celebrate the Feast of the Chair of St. Peter. Traditionally, it is a time to recognize that St. Peter was chosen to be first among equals, and that Pope Francis, as the successor to St. Peter, and all the other bishops, as successors to the Apostles, continue the sacred ministry that was begun by the Lord Himself while he lived on earth. As we begin the season of Lent on Wednesday, let us pray in a special way for Pope Francis, Bishop Brennan, and all those who lead the Church.



Kingdom only through the sy to hell' is broad, and in my who choose that way avery narrow and the sy cost find it. Abstinence: All the faithful who have reached 14 years of age are required to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.

Fasting: All the faithful between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday. Fasting means limiting oneself to one full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may be taken on two other occasions during the day. Coffee, tea and juice are permitted at any time.

Easter Duty: After they have been fully initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, all the faithful are bound to receive Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept must be fulfilled in the Easter Season unless, for a good reason, it is fulfilled at another time. By special permission, in the USA, the period for fulfilling this precept is extended to include the period from the 1st Sunday of Lent (February 26 until Pentecost (May 28).
