Dear Friends,

On the First Sunday of Lent we always enter the desert with Jesus, where he fasts for forty days before He is tempted by the devil. We are only asked to fast for two days during the season of Lent, but we spend our whole lives being tempted by sin. Let us pray for the strength and courage we need to rely on the Lord to deliver us from sin and to lead us on the path to salvation. May the Lord bless us during this Lenten season.

3. Fridays – Stations of the Cross in English after the noon Mass
4. Saturdays – 3:30-4:30 PM – Holy Hour with confessions
5. Friday, March 3 – First Friday Devotions will take place after Stations of the Cross with Eucharistic Adoration until 2:00 PM.
6. Saturday, March 18 – Lenten Soup Supper after the 5:00 PM Mass hosted by the Youth Group
7. Monday, April 3 – Reconciliation Monday

Fr. Chin was delayed by two days because of the fire in Terminal 1 at JFK, but he finally arrived safely in Vietnam. He will return to NY at the end of this week. We pray for a good visit with his family and a safe return to the United States.

Every Lent, the Diocese of Brooklyn announces a new Annual Catholic Appeal. Once again, our goal here at St. Luke is \$100,274.00. We might take our time, but eventually our parish meets and surpasses the goal for the appeal. Remember that any monies collected over the goal return to the parish, so thank you for all your efforts to support the diocese and the parish.

This year, as a part of the Eucharistic Revival that is being promoted by the Church, the Diocese of Brooklyn has announced a Lenten Pilgrimage of Eucharistic Adoration around the diocese, beginning at St. James Cathedral in Brooklyn and ending in Maspeth. Locally, the pilgrimage will arrive at Mary's Nativity/St. Ann Parish on March 22<sup>nd</sup>, and then at St. Andrew Avellino Parish on March 23<sup>rd</sup>. As the dates get closer, we will promote the pilgrimage in the bulletin. 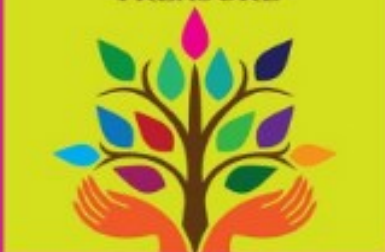

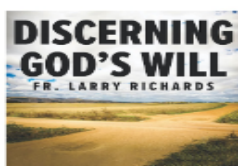
### Father Michael McGivney: An American Blessed
