On the First Sunday of Lent we always enter the desert with Jesus, where he fasts for forty days before He is tempted by the devil. We are only asked to fast for two days during the season of Lent, but we spend our whole lives being tempted by sin. Let us pray for the strength and courage we need to rely on the Lord to deliver us from sin and to lead us on the path to salvation. May the Lord bless us during this Lenten season.

This year, as a part of the Eucharistic Revival that is being promoted by the Church, the Diocese of Brooklyn has announced a Lenten Pilgrimage of Eucharistic Adoration around the diocese, beginning at St. James Cathedral in Brooklyn and ending in Maspeth. Locally, the pilgrimage will arrive at Mary's Nativity/St. Ann Parish on March 22nd, and then at St. Andrew Avellino Parish on March 23rd.
