

Third Sunday of Lent

Dear Friends,

Daylight Savings Time starts this weekend, so we continue to make progress to the first day of spring on March 20th. On this Third Sunday of Lent we turn to John's Gospel and hear the story of Jesus' encounter with the Samaritan woman at the well. She eventually comes to believe that Jesus is the Messiah, and she goes into the town to tell the people about Jesus. Many came to believe because of her testimony, but eventually, "many more began to believe in him because of his word, and they said to the woman, 'We no longer believe because of your word; for we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this is truly the savior of the world." Giving witness to the impact of Jesus in our lives can be a powerful means of conversion for others. We pray the Lord will strengthen us so that through our words and deeds, others will come to know and love Jesus.

Friday is St. Patrick's Day. Many parishioners (including myself!) trace their family tree back to Ireland; a number of parishioners are Irish immigrants themselves. As we celebrate St. Patrick's Day, we give thanks for the contributions of the Irish to our country and to our local community here in Whitestone. Because it falls on a Friday, Bishop Brennan has given a dispensation for abstaining from meat, but those who choose to use the dispensation are reminded that they should substitute another penitential practice or act of charity to keep the spirit of Lent. On Sunday, March 19th, after the noon Mass, there will be a light "Irish breakfast" served in the Pastoral Center, and the raffle will be drawn.

Traditionally March 19th is the Solemnity of St. Joseph, but because it falls on a Sunday this year, the celebration is moved to Monday, March 20th. St. Joseph was chosen by God to be the husband of Mary and the foster-father of Jesus, so he has a special role in providing for the Holy Family and helping to raise Jesus. Celebrating St. Joseph is particularly dear to the Italian culture. Bread will be blessed in honor of St. Joseph during the Italian Mass next Sunday, and we will have a dinner-dance in honor of St. Joseph on Saturday, March 25th.

In light of both celebrations for St. Patrick and St. Joseph, I thank Philomena Nicaj, Lisa Scardamaglia and Deirdre Zuccarello for organizing our St. Patrick celebration, and Damiana Testa for her work in organizing the dinner dance. We are truly blessed with generous volunteers in our parish!

Don't forget that next Saturday, after the 5:00 PM Mass, the Youth Group is sponsoring the annual Lenten Soup Supper. Several parishioners volunteer to make soups so that our community can share a simple meal together as we journey with one another through the forty days. Please come and support the Youth Group as they serve our community!

We will do a food collection on the last weekend of March to help provide supplies to the food pantry at Grace Episcopal Church so that they have enough food to distribute to families for Easter. Please see the ad in the bulletin for the types of food needed. Thank you in advance for your generosity!

Finally, I am happy to announce that a troupe from Creative Ministries will come to St. Luke on Saturday, April 1st to perform *Journey, Cross & Crucifixion*, a musical and dramatic presentation of the Lord's Passion. It will be a beautiful way to enter into Holy Week together.







Mary has been involved in music ministry at St. Luke's for over 40 years, has been a member of the Parish Council, and has helped to organize various parish Lenten programs and days of reflection. She currently assists with the Bereavement Group and enjoys writing spiritual reflections.
