

Fourth Sunday of Lent

Dear Friends,

March 19th is the traditional Solemnity of St. Joseph, but because it falls on a Sunday of Lent, the solemnity is transferred to Monday. However, here at St. Luke we will have the blessing and distribution of bread in honor of St. Joseph during the Italian Mass, and we will remember St. Patrick and St. Joseph at the noon Mass this weekend, while still celebrating *Lætare Sunday*. I am grateful to all those who have prepared a simple "Irish Breakfast" after the noon Mass, and I look forward to the St. Joseph Dinner-Dance next weekend.

Tomorrow is the first day of spring. My "hardware store-owning brother" was not too happy with the very mild winter, but I was glad to not have to worry about snow removal and cancelling school or Masses during this past winter. Keep your eyes to the skies ... Easter comes on the Sunday after the first full moon of spring, so after Tuesday's new moon, the moon will get brighter and brighter and lead us to our celebration of the Passion, Death and Resurrection of the Lord. Remember to *turn away from sin and be faithful to the gospel!*

On this *Lætare Sunday* we hear the gospel of the man born blind. In most healing stories, the sick person calls out to Jesus requesting to be healed. Here, Jesus sees the man born blind as He is passing by and sends the man to wash at the pool of Siloam after he smears his eyes with the clay. Jesus wants us to see. There is too much in our world that tries to obscure our view. Even our own sinfulness can prevent us from seeing clearly. Let us accept the gift of Jesus to remove our blindness, and then commit ourselves to put our sight to good use to recognize the needs of others and to respond to them in love.

We had a pastors' meeting with Bishop Brennan last Tuesday. One of the important topics that was discussed was "Parish Partnerships." As the number of priests and religious goes down the bishop is looking for new ways of providing the best pastoral and sacramental ministry to the faithful of the diocese. There are currently 178 parishes, which includes 21 merged parishes with 2 sites and 4 merged parishes with 3 sites. There are also 9 pairs (i.e. 18 parishes) in a partnership. Since 1999, there has been a 40% decrease in Mass attendance in the diocese. In 2022, there were 231 priests assigned in active ministry, with 209 assigned to parishes. There is currently 1 priest under 30; 39 priests between 31-40; 44 priests between 41-50; 71 priests between 51-60; 77 priests between 61-70; and 166 priests over 70, with 118 over retirement age. The bishop is talking about parishes sharing resources and personnel in these partnerships. We also need to look at Mass schedules and the capacity of our churches as we plan. The conversation has started at the diocesan level, but we need to work together in our parish and in our deanery to pray well and plan well so that the Church will continue to serve the people of Brooklyn and Queens for many years to come.

On Good Friday this year, we will have Stations of the Cross for children at 12:00 PM. I asked the art teacher in St. Luke School to guide the children in grades 2 to 8 in drawing the Stations that we will use. They did an awesome job! Please plan on joining us!



- Each session will provide an opportunity to prayerfully reflect on the Gospel from the previous Sunday.



FR. JUNHEE LEE was ordained to the priesthood for the Diocese of Brooklyn in 2013. Fr. Lee was briefly assigned to the Incarnation Parish before returning to Rome to complete his STL (Licentiate in Sacred Theology) in Dogmatic studies.

Upon returning to the diocese, he was assigned as parochial vicar at St. Mel's parish in Flushing until 2018. During this time, Fr. Lee was one of four diocesan regional vocation directors and a part-time teacher at Cathedral Preparatory School and Seminary in Elmhurst, where he is currently in residence. From 2018 to 2022, Fr. Lee was released from the diocesan ministry for post-ordination studies in Clinical Psychology and Mental Health Counseling.

Upon completing his Master in Education and Masters in Psychology from Fordham University and Divine Mercy University, Fr. Lee is completing his internship as a Mental Health Counselor at Queens College Counseling Services while assisting weekend Masses at St. Luke's and other parishes in need.






Prayer for St. Joseph's Protection
