

Fifth Sunday of Lent

Dear Friends,

I am happy to welcome speakers from *Retrouvaille* this weekend. Many of you may have heard of **Marriage Encounter**, which is a program designed to help good marriages to become stronger. *Retrouvaille* uses the framework of Marriage Encounter but is designed to help couples who are struggling in their marriages to bring healing and hope to their relationships. *Retrouvaille* is a French word that means *rediscovery*, and many couples have saved their marriages by experiencing the *Retrouvaille* program. I hope that any struggling marriages here at St. Luke will benefit from the talks that will be given this weekend.

On this Fifth Sunday of Lent we hear the story of the raising of Lazarus. Previously, Jesus cast out demons, gave sight to the blind, let the mute speak, allowed the lame to walk ... but to raise from the dead! This passage is found in the eleventh chapter of John's gospel. While that may seem early, Jesus enters Jerusalem in the twelfth chapter, and His Passion begins to unfold. In reality, the raising of Lazarus becomes a turning point. The Jewish leaders are threatened by the power manifested by Christ, and so they begin the plan to put him to death. Next week is Palm Sunday, so we are quickly approaching our celebration of the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of the Lord.

I'm glad to see so many of the "traditional events" returning to our parish. Last weekend on Saturday we had a wonderful Soup Supper sponsored by the Youth Group, and on Sunday we had a very nice gathering in honor of St. Patrick with lots of soda bread and other treats. Congratulations to Doreen Idarecis who won the 50/50 raffle! This weekend the Supermarket Bingo came back to the school, and the dinner-dance in honor of St. Joseph was celebrated this weekend as well. Recently a few people have been inquiring about the Carnival. There is no Carnival scheduled for this year. One concern I have is the potential damage to the newly paved school parking lot. More important, though, is the need for volunteers. It's not easy to find volunteers, and an event like Carnival needs a lot of volunteers to assure its safety and success. I am open to discussing the possibility of scheduling a Carnival for next year ... we can certainly use the proceeds from such a major fundraiser! In the meantime, I am grateful to Sal Colak and Sabato Daniele and everyone who is helping them to organize the 3rd annual Golf Outing to help raise money for St. Luke!

Next weekend we will welcome Creative Ministries and their presentation of *Journey, Cross and Crucifixion*. It will take place on Saturday, April 1st at 8:00 PM. Please spread the word and invite your neighbors and friends to this special event. No tickets are needed, and a good will offering will be collected to help support their ministry. I believe it will be a beautiful way for our parish to enter into Holy Week. Looking ahead, on Wednesday of Holy Week we will show the final episode of Franco Zeffirelli's *Jesus of Nazareth* in the Msgr. Tosi Pastoral Center at 7:00 PM. Also, don't forget the Children's Stations of the Cross on Good Friday at 12:00 PM.
