Dear Friends,

We were truly blessed with our Holy Week celebrations here at St. Luke. On Reconciliation Monday, Fr. Chin and I heard confessions for about an hour and a half after the noon Mass, and then for a solid three hours during Eucharistic Adoration from 6:00 to 9:00 PM. What a privilege it was for us to be the instruments of the Lord to bring healing and reconciliation to so many people! On Tuesday, we attended the Chrism Mass at the Co-Cathedral of St. Joseph. The Chrism Mass is always such a wonderful event for priests, since we have the chance to enjoy one another's company and then to recommit ourselves to our service as priests by renewing our ordination promises before the bishop.

On Wednesday evening, about a dozen of us watched the final episode of Franco Zeffirelli's *Jesus of Nazareth* in the Msgr. Tosi Pastoral Center. For the Triduum, we had Morning Prayer each day at 9:00 AM. On Holy Thursday evening, we had more than a dozen people for the *mandatum* (washing of the feet), and we had a beautiful procession of the Blessed Sacrament to the Repository which was set up in the Pastoral Center. Many people stayed for a while, and about 20 people were still there at 11:00 PM when we prayed Night Prayer before returning the Eucharist to the sacristy. On Good Friday I was so happy with the Stations of the Cross for children at Noon. There was a very nice crowd of families and parishioners to pray together with the Stations that were illustrated by our St. Luke School children, with prayers led with a number of children from our School of Religion. There is a page dedicated to the Children's Stations in this week's bulletin. The Liturgy of the Lord's Passion at 3:00 PM had a very nice crowd and was very prayerful and reverent as we proclaimed the Passion from John's Gospel and returned to the regular Veneration of the Cross. A smaller but nice-sized crowd came in the evening for Stations and Veneration of the Cross. Later in the evening, the church was filled with people who joined the Borgetto community for a procession with *Gesù morto* (dead Jesus) and *l'Adolorata* (the Sorrowful Mother) from St. Mel.

On Holy Saturday, Fr. Chin was the presider, and he had the opportunity for the first time as a priest to confer the Sacrament of Confirmation on Spencer Liu, who was formerly Lutheran but is now a fully initiated Catholic. Callistus did a beautiful job chanting the Exultet once the Paschal candle was blessed and lit and processed into the church.

Once again, I can't help but recognize how truly blessed we are here at St. Luke. I am grateful for all of our parish staff and volunteers who worked so hard to prepare for our inspiring liturgies. I am grateful for members of the Italian community who helped to adorn the Repository and the church with traditional grains and flowers. The scouts always help to prepare the fire and to keep us safe. The choir helped us to pray twice with the gift of song; our lectors proclaimed the readings reverently; the Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion helped with the distribution of Communion to the crowds who gathered; the servers went through practices to prepare to serve the liturgies; the ushers helped to collect the offerings and coordinate processions. Peter Paolo was helped by Nick Scardamaglia in the sacristy to make sure everything was properly coordinated behind the scenes. Finally, the presence of so many parishioners, friends and visitors helped to make our celebrations so beautiful. May the Lord's Divine Mercy continue to heal us and give us hope!
