Dear Friends,

This is always such a beautiful time of year in the Church. This weekend we celebrated First Holy Communion with the children of St. Luke School, and in May we will celebrate First Communion for the children in our Religious Education Program. We also look forward to Bishop Chappetto's return to NY in mid-May, when he will confer the Sacrament of Confirmation on the young people of our parish. As always, we pray that the conferral of the sacraments will be a time of renewed commitment for parents to show their children, by their own example, the importance of the regular practice of our faith.

On this 3rd Sunday of Easter we are given one of the classic passages of the resurrection ... *The Road to Emmaus*. The disciples encounter Jesus along their way from Jerusalem to Emmaus but are prevented from recognizing Him. As they walk with Him, their hearts are warmed by their discussion, as Jesus shows how the Scriptures referred to Himself and all the events that had just taken place. When they arrive at their destination, they invite Jesus: "Stay with us." As Jesus breaks the bread, they finally recognize Him, but He vanished from their sight. When these disciples return to Jerusalem, there are other accounts of seeing the Risen Lord. I believe that this is a passage to which so many of us can relate. How often have we been afraid, or confused, or bereaved and have said, "Stay with me, Lord." To be surrounded by the loving presence of Jesus is such a great consolation to us as we experience the difficult moments in life ... Stay with us, Lord!

On Tuesday this week the Church celebrates the feast of St. Mark, whom biblical scholars believe wrote the first account of the gospel. He likely wrote his gospel between 60-70 AD, and much of it comes from the teachings of St. Peter. The gospels of Matthew, Mark and Luke are known as *Synoptic Gospels*: they share a similar format and contain many of the same stories. John's gospel is very different from the other three. Since it was written first, Mark's gospel was a likely source for both Matthew and Luke. St. Mark was likely the first bishop of Alexandria. In the 9th century, his relics were stolen and brought to Venice, where a beautiful cathedral contains his relics to this day. As a parish whose patron is one of the evangelists, we know how important these writings are for the life of the Church. As familiar as we may feel with the stories recounted in the gospels, they are always a source of inspiration and growth for us as disciples of the Lord.

We are making progress in our goal for the Annual Catholic Appeal, but we still have a long way to go. I thank all those who have already contributed or made a pledge to help us to achieve and hopefully surpass our goal of \$100,274. We will soon do an in-pew solicitation to help increase our parish's gifts and pledges. As you know, we also have the 3rd annual golf outing coming up in June. Sal Colak and Sabato Daniele work hard with their committees and volunteers to make this a very successful event for our parish. Please consider supporting the golf outing as a sponsor, and please take a chance in the 300 Club 50/50 Raffle. We rely on your generous support, and we are truly grateful!








Can You Trust God? by Dr. Tim Gray
