Dear Friends,

From the middle of the 19th century, there has been a worldwide movement to highlight the rights of workers, and May 1st became the day to remember the struggle for an 8-hour workday for the working class. In 1955, in the midst of the Cold War and the influence of the Soviet Union and communism in the world, Pope Pius XII established the feast of St. Joseph the Worker on May 1st to highlight the dignity of human labor and the example of St. Joseph as a counter to the secular celebrations. The month of May has also traditionally been a time for the Church to honor the Blessed Virgin Mary, and so tomorrow we join with the whole Church as we celebrate Mary and Joseph. In particular, we pray for all mothers as we anticipate the celebration of Mother's Day on May 14th; may Mary be a tireless intercessor for all mothers. We also pray for all workers, especially for those who may be unemployed or underemployed, that the intercession of St. Joseph might be fruitful in their pursuits to provide for themselves and their families and to experience the dignity of human labor.

We had a beautiful celebration of First Holy Communion for the children of St. Luke School last weekend. We look ahead in May to Bishop Chappetto conferring the Sacrament of Confirmation on our young people on May 16th, and then First Holy Communion for the children in our Religious Education program on May 20th. At this time of year, not only do we have our parish celebrations taking place, but parishioners are running back and forth to their family celebrations of all the sacraments: Baptisms, First Communions, Confirmations, Weddings. It's wonderful when there are happy occasions to celebrate with family and friends, and it certainly makes the month fly by! Congratulations to all those who are celebrating at this time of year.

I thank the Knights of Columbus for a very successful Pasta Night to support the great work done by Bridge to Life. In the midst of the event, the Scardamaglia Family found out that they were named the New York State Knights of Columbus Family of the Year. Of course, Lisa has worked with our Religious Education Program for many years and is involved with the Parish Council, the Martha Ministry, and so many other facets of parish life. Damian is always available to volunteer with security for the Religious Education program, or helping to coordinate our food collection for the food pantry at Grace Episcopal Church, or anything else that might be needed. Their son, Nicholas, too, is always ready to help as a server, Extraordinary Minister, sacristan, and catechist. The Scardamaglias give so much time to the parish and local community, and so we are glad to congratulate them for this great honor.

The Fourth Sunday of Easter is known as Good Shepherd Sunday because the gospel in all three liturgical years focuses on Christ, the Good Shepherd. It is also celebrated as a World Day of Prayer for Vocations, since it is the Good Shepherd who invites us to, "Pray the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into his harvest." We have been blessed this year to have Callistus Ibeh among us for his Pastoral Year as a seminarian for the Diocese of Brooklyn. Our parish has been blessed to have several seminarians serve our community over the years, but it has been a while since our parish produced a vocation to the priesthood or consecrated life. I'd love to see married men in our community consider a vocation to the diaconate! Please pray for vocations ... they are much needed!




St. Joseph: Old and New (Part 1 of 4)




Saint Athanasius of Alexandria | Catholic Saints

They had so much fun! Especially when they got to eat the chocolate kiss.











Any items that may have been forgotten in church (glasses, Rosary Beads, etc.) and turned in will be found in the Sacristy; that can be visited before or after Masses.


