Dear Friends,

On this Fifth Sunday of Easter we hear about a particular need that arose in the early community in the Acts of the Apostles. It seems that everyone kept turning to the apostles with their various issues and concerns, and it became apparent that the apostles just couldn't properly respond to everything that was brought to them. Therefore, they ordained the first deacons: "seven reputable men, filled with the Spirit and wisdom, whom we shall appoint to this task, whereas we shall devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word. "From the period immediately after the Lord's resurrection, deacons have taken up a ministry of service, particularly to widows, orphans, and the poor. As you know, since his ordination in 2021. Deacon John Kramer was assigned by the diocese to serve two parish communities: Holy Trinity and St. Luke. Deacons are instructed that their commitment to their families and their work takes precedence, and so they do their best to make themselves available for the ministry for which they have been ordained. Before Deacon John, St. Luke was served by a local parishioner, Deacon Harry Svebel, for many years. I would love to see one or two men from our parish to prayerfully consider the vocation to become a permanent deacon. Please feel free to speak with either me or Deacon John if you are interested.

For several months now we have had Eucharistic Adoration while priests are available for confession on Saturday afternoons from 3:30 to 4:30 PM. It seems that for the most part there is at least one person in church during that time, though there are usually more, and there are usually several people there for benediction. The Church is trying to promote a Eucharistic Revival now that the pandemic is in the past. To renew ourselves in Eucharistic devotion is a wonderful sign of our relationship with Jesus, Who is present Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity in the Eucharist. Looking ahead, on Thursday, June 8th, the "traditional" day to celebrate Corpus Christi, our deanery will gather here for a special celebration. Bishop Chappetto will celebrate the Mass, and there will be an indoor procession with the Blessed Sacrament. More information will follow, but please plan on joining the other parishes of our deanery in this special Eucharistic celebration.

May is the Month of Mary, and so the whole Church takes the opportunity to honor the Mother of God. In last week's bulletin, we included a page showing how to pray the Rosary. Every year we have a crowning of Mary's statue with the children of our parish. On Mondays all year long we pray a Novena to the Miraculous Medal. Mary is a beautiful gift to all of us, and any opportunity we have to honor the Blessed Virgin is another means of being brought closer to her son, Jesus. Remember to honor Mary during her special month!

Next Saturday, the Msgr. Dillon Council of the Knights of Columbus is sponsoring the 2nd Annual Car Show in our school parking lot. Admission is free and there will be music, food, and a lot of classic cars. All the proceeds will go to charity, and all are welcome!
