Let us remember all the deceased members of our parish. Seventh Sunday of Easter (The Ascension of The Lord)

Dear Friends,

It has been a busy week with special celebrations, and I thank God for the many blessings that He showered down on St. Luke with the celebrations of Confirmation, First Communions, and Ascension Thursday. Many parishioners are participating in family sacramental celebrations here and elsewhere. Ironically, we have no more weddings scheduled here at St. Luke until July. May God bless all our family and friends who are receiving sacraments at this time of year!

On this Seventh Sunday of Easter we are entering the final week of the Easter Season, and we join with the whole Church in praying for a renewal in the Holy Spirit. In John's Gospel, the Last Supper begins with Chapter 12. Today we read from Chapter 17, known as Jesus' High Priestly Prayer or his Farewell Discourse. It is the longest prayer of Jesus in any of the gospels, and it manifests the multilayered love between Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, and between God and His people. When this prayer ends, Jesus goes to the Garden of Gethsemane in Chapter 18, and then His Passion begins.

It was about 8 years since the church floors had a thorough cleaning, and I was glad we were able to get it done before Confirmation. The mechanics came recently to prep the church and Pastoral Center air conditioning systems for the upcoming summer season. These two maintenance projects alone cost almost \$10,000. I think it's important to give parishioners an idea from time to time about costs like these that are incurred by the parish. We rely on your generous support to keep St. Luke beautiful. Thank you!

This weekend we will have the installation of new liturgical ministers for our parish. We are always grateful when people come forward for training and service for our community. When the Church speaks of stewardship, she speaks of time, talent, and treasure. We are grateful for all the ways our parishioners contribute to our community, and those who minister share their time and talent with us. May God bless all who serve!

St. Luke School has the custom of a May Crowning on the Friday of Memorial Day weekend. This coming Friday at 10:30 AM we will have a liturgy for crowning a statue of the Blessed Mother. There will be limited seating for parishioners, but we pray that Our Lady will inspire our young people to draw close to Jesus throughout their lives and to rely on her intercession.

The diocese has every parish take a count of all those present at Masses on two weekends in May and two weekends in November each year. We took a count last weekend: Saturday 5:00 PM - 165 people; Sunday 7:30 AM - 110 people; 9:00 AM (Italian) - 100 people; 10:30 AM - 190 people; 12:00 PM - 170 people; 5:00 PM - 90 people. We will also count the congregation at all Masses this weekend. We estimate that our church can hold around 750. I thought you might be interested in this information.






The Holy Spirit: Third Person of the Trinity by Fr. Shannon Collins
