## Pentecost Sunday

Dear Friends,

Today the Church brings the Easter Season to an end with Pentecost. The ten extra days of the Easter Season after Ascension Thursday are a period of prayer and anticipation for a renewal of the Holy Spirit in our hearts and in the Church. Here at St. Luke, I will have the privilege of conferring the Sacrament of Confirmation on four adults who have been preparing for the sacrament over these past several weeks. We pray for them and for all those in our community who received Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Eucharist, Confirmation) during this holy season. As the Paschal Candle returns from the ambo to the Baptismal font during Ordinary Time, may we keep the flame of faith burning brightly in all our hearts.

This is also Memorial Day weekend. I have been asked to offer the blessing at the Whitestone Veteran's Memorial during the ceremony that precedes the parade to honor those who made the ultimate sacrifice serving our country. Of course, our weekday Mass on Memorial Day gives us a chance to pray for the repose of their souls, while at the same time praying for God's protection on those who are currently serving our country. Mass on federal holidays is celebrated at 9:30 AM in our parish, and all are welcome!

On Thursday this week, our parish will host the Baccalaureate Mass for Holy Cross High School. As you know, I am an alumnus and former board member of Holy Cross, so I am happy to welcome my alma mater to St. Luke as the class of 2023 prepares for graduation. We certainly extend our congratulations to all our parishioners who are graduating from high school this year: we pray that God will continue to guide you as you begin college in the fall, or in whatever you will begin to pursue as a high school graduate.

The month of May concludes with the Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The second Joyful Mystery of the Rosary recalls that Mary, after the Archangel Gabriel gives her the Good News that she has been chosen by God to be the Mother of Jesus, goes to visit her cousin, Elizabeth, who, in her old age has conceived John the Baptist. In February of 1994, Mother Theresa of Calcutta addressed the National Prayer breakfast in Washington, DC, and she said, "And God loved the world so much that He gave His son — it was a giving. God gave His son to the Virgin Mary, and what did she do with Him? As soon as Jesus came into Mary's life, immediately she went in haste to give that good news. And as she came into the house of her cousin, Elizabeth, Scripture tells us that the unborn child — the child in the womb of Elizabeth — leapt with joy. While still in the womb of Mary — Jesus brought peace to John the Baptist who leapt for joy in the womb of Elizabeth."

The season of ordination anniversaries has begun. Tomorrow, May 29<sup>th</sup>, Bishop Chappetto will celebrate his 52<sup>nd</sup> anniversary of priestly ordination; on July 11<sup>th</sup>, he will celebrate the 11<sup>th</sup> anniversary of his ordination as a bishop. Tomorrow also marks the 2<sup>nd</sup> anniversary of Deacon John Kramer's ordination as a deacon. On June 5<sup>th</sup>, Fr. Chin will celebrate his second anniversary as a priest. Later in the month, on June 24<sup>th</sup>, I will celebrate my 34<sup>th</sup> anniversary of ordination. Please pray for the parish clergy, and pray, too, for more vocations to Holy Orders and consecrated life.


## LOST and FOUND in St. Luke Church
