Dear Friends.

Now that June is here the summer will truly begin before we know it. Today the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. Of course, St. Patrick is famous for using the shamrock as a way to explain the Trinity because the three leaves grow out of a single stem. Obviously, we will never fully grasp the mystery of the Holy Trinity, but it is important to consider how Divine Love characterizes the relationship between Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, which then overflows into God's relationship with us. Love is truly the essence of the mystery of the Holy Trinity.

I want to point out a special deanery event that will take place at St. Luke this week. On Thursday, June 8th, Bishop Chappetto will preside as we celebrate the Votive Mass of the Holy Eucharist will all the parishes of our deanery. The Church in the United States is promoting a Eucharistic Revival, and this event is a way for our local community to participate in it. The Mass will end with a period of Adoration and then a procession through the church before concluding with benediction. Afterwards we will host a reception in the Monsignor Tosi Pastoral Center to join with parishioners from our deanery parishes for some fellowship. I hope that our parish will be well-represented for this special community event.

After the Vigil Mass of Corpus Christi next Saturday, we will have a Corpus Christi procession. This wonderful tradition allows us to bring our faith into the streets of our community as we honor the Blessed Sacrament. The procession will go up Locke Avenue and around the block before returning up Clintonville Street and back to church for benediction. Fr. Chin and Callistus are working with a group of parishioners to coordinate the event. I pray that it will be a beautiful expression of our Catholic faith in our community.

Callistus Ibeh has been here at St. Luke for his Pastoral Year since around Labor Day, and he will be with us until mid-July when he will go to Nigeria for a visit with his family before returning to the seminary. We have been truly blessed to have him among us, and we certainly will continue to pray for him and support him as he continues with his priestly formation. We will have a Farewell Mass on Sunday, July 2nd at 12:00 PM, followed by a luncheon in the Pastoral Center to pray with him and to show him our love and support. There is a form in the bulletin so families can RSVP to help us properly prepare for the luncheon. I hope many families, especially the young people from the school and religious ed program, will make the effort to be a part of the celebration.

Looking ahead to the summer, Bishop Chappetto will be helping us cover Masses and other pastoral needs during July and August. He will also be assisting at Holy Trinity in Whitestone, since the pastor, Fr. Gibino, has been reassigned, and the new pastor cannot arrive until mid-August. I will be taking vacation during the month of July, and Fr. Chin will be taking the month of August. Like last year, there will be no 5:00 PM Mass on Sundays during July and August; it will return after Labor Day. Daily Mass from Monday to Friday will be celebrated at noon; there will be no 8:30 AM Masses on Tuesdays and Thursdays once school is over. We will remind you of the schedule in the bulletin and at Mass during the announcements.
