The Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)

June 11, 2023

Dear Friends,

Sometimes at this time of year unexpected transitions take place in the diocese. I recently received a call from a senior priest looking for a new residence. Fr. Bill Krlis (CURL iss) is the retired pastor of Most Precious Blood Church in Astoria, and he asked if we had room here at St. Luke. He came over for dinner to meet with Fr. Chin and me and to see the accommodations. I am happy to announce that he will take up residence here at St. Luke later this month.

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ – formerly "Corpus Christi." This is the final "special Sunday" after Easter before we return to Ordinary Time Masses on Sundays. Especially since the pandemic, the Church is trying to renew all Catholics in our understanding of the Eucharist as the Real Presence of Jesus – Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. Our deanery celebration this past Thursday and our own Eucharistic procession on Saturday night this weekend allows us to manifest our faith in Jesus in a very special way. I hope that our opportunities for Eucharistic Adoration on Saturdays from 3:30 to 4:30 PM, on First Fridays after the noon Mass until 2:00 PM, and at other times during the year will help our own faith community foster a rekindled appreciation for the Real Presence of the Lord among us in the Eucharist.

On Thursday and Friday this week, we will celebrate graduation events for the Class of 2023 of St. Luke School. I am truly grateful to Mrs. Brunswick, Mrs. Mezic, and all the faculty and staff of our school for their hard work and sacrifices that allow us to provide a Catholic education to the families of our community. It is increasingly difficult to maintain a Catholic School and to provide a dedicated and committed staff, so we are grateful to the parents who entrust their children to us and to everyone who facilities our program. I am sure that everyone is looking forward to the last day of school to enjoy some rest and relaxation after another school year!

Just a reminder that we are hosting Early Voting again in the Parish Center. The machines will arrive on Friday, June 16th, and voting will take place through Sunday, June 25th. For security reasons, parish groups cannot use the Parish Center during that period. I apologize for the inconvenience and I thank you for your understanding. The compensation we receive from the Board of Elections certainly makes it worth our while to make the space available.

I attended a Pastors Meeting with Bishop Brennan this past Tuesday, and he raised the issue of the Migrant Crisis in our diocese. Msgr. LoPinto, the Director of Catholic Charities, reported that there are many young women delivering their children who need diapers, strollers, baby food, etc. The pastor of St. Pius V in Jamaica said that his parish feeds between 75-150 migrants everyday, and they need provisions of things like chicken, beans, and rice to provide food for those who come. If anyone is interested in coordinating efforts here at St. Luke to try to provide for these needs, please let me know.
