Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Friends,

Back in the mid-1990's I was appointed Director of Family Life Ministry of the diocese. I had completed my license in Sacred Theology at the John Paul II Institute for Studies on Marriage and Family in Rome, and so when the office needed a new director, Bishop Daily appointed me to the position. One aspect of the ministry was that I was also a member of the Evangelization Commission. Since the Jubilee Year 2000 was fast approaching, Bishop Daily asked the Commission to propose diocesan celebrations for the Jubilee Year. When we reported back to the bishop, we made several proposals, figuring the bishop would choose from among them. Instead, the bishop decided that we should celebrate all of them. Our proposal included outdoor Rosary Rallies in Brooklyn and Queens on March 25th followed by breakout sessions for the different language groups in nearby churches; Eucharistic processions going from parish to parish around the diocese; and a major daylong event at Arthur Ashe Stadium on June 24th. It was clear that these events would need someone to coordinate them to plan and execute all the details. When the chairperson suggested to Bishop Daily that someone be appointed as director, he looked across the table at me and said, "John Costello can do it." I was taken a little aback, and so I asked the bishop if it would be in addition to Family Life Ministry, or if it would be a full-time position. Without missing a beat, he said, "If I can do everything I'm doing as Bishop of Brooklyn, you can do them both together." At the time, I was in my early 30s and he was turning 70, and so I carried out both ministries simultaneously until the upcoming events required full-time attention. By the way, preparing those events for the Jubilee Year required that I work closely with Msgr. Tosi, who was Director of Liturgy at the time.

Now, as I am approaching 60 years of age, Bishop Brennan is asking me to add an additional diocesan ministry while I continue to serve as pastor of St. Luke. Certainly it is an honor to be asked to serve as Regional Vicar of Queens East, and I will take on important responsibilities with the deaneries and parishes in my Vicariate as well as being on the "bishop's cabinet" to deal with wider issues in the diocese. Because of the significant workload that has been given to me, the diocese will reimburse the parish for a portion of my salary and benefits. Certainly, we are blessed to have Fr. Chin assigned to our parish. He has grown a lot as a priest over these past two years, and I believe he is ready to take on more responsibilities. Of course, Bishop Chappetto will continue to be available to assist us with liturgies while he is in NY every year, and Fr. Krlis will also be available to assist us once he settles in and is relieved of his other commitments in Astoria. I ask for your patience and understanding as I try my best to balance both responsibilities. Clearly, calendar planning will be an essential part of keeping me available to both the parish and my vicariate. Also, promoting more leadership among parishioners will help us to build our community and find ways to organize fundraising activities as well as events that will meet the needs of our parishioners and help us to reach out to others. Let us support one another in prayer!

Today we are happy to celebrate with Callistus as his pastoral year comes to an end. He has been a great help around the parish, he has engaged with parishioners of all ages, and his pastoral experiences have helped him to become more aware of the daily life of priests in the Diocese of Brooklyn. We wish him a happy visit with his family and friends back in Nigeria before he returns to his studies at St. Joseph Seminary in Yonkers. We look forward to his visits back to St. Luke, and, God-willing, to his future diaconal and priestly ministry.
