#### Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

July 30, 2023

Dear Friends,

As we get ready to bid farewell to July this week, Fr. Chin will be leaving for Vietnam to have an extended visit with his family. We pray for his safe travels and extend our best wishes to him as he gets to spend time with his loved ones. I am back from time away with my family and friends, and so I will be working to get ready for the new pastoral year beginning after Labor Day.

A couple of people have mentioned to me their interest in a parish pilgrimage to the Holy Land. Others have mentioned Guadalupe or Rome. I don't know if our parish would have enough interest to provide an adequate number of people for a pilgrimage on our own, so I may reach out to other parishes in our deanery to see if we could work together to organize a pilgrimage to some of the holy places. I've lived in Rome and I've been to the Holy Land twice, so both of those destinations are dear to my heart. I've also been to Lourdes and Medjugorje, but never to Fatima. Guadalupe is on my "spiritual" bucket list. A pilgrimage is a wonderful experience of traveling to holy places to recognize God's abundant grace being poured out in special ways. Let me know if you are interested.

At the same time, there are local pilgrimage sites that we may be able to organize: Shrine of Our Lady of the Island; Mother Cabrini Shrine; Padre Pio Shrine in New Jersey; Divine Mercy Shrine in Massachusetts. Some of these shrines are near enough to make it easy for families to participate. If anyone would like to help chair a pilgrimage to these or other shrines, let me know.

Every year on August 4<sup>th</sup> the Church celebrates the Memorial of St. John Vianney, the patron of priests. He was a very humble man who spent long hours in the confessional of his parish church for the conversion of the people entrusted to his care. Pope Benedict XVI declared a Year of the Priest from 2009-2010, and I had the opportunity to make my annual retreat in Ars, the town of his parish church, just as the holy year was coming to an end. Then, when I was on the faculty of Cathedral Seminary House of Formation in Douglaston, the relic of his heart was traveling through the US and made a stop at the Immaculate Conception Center. It was a privilege to be in the presence of his relic and to pray for his intercession for my priestly ministry.

We have a statue of St. John Vianney by the metal staircase that leads up to the sacristy. As you pass that statue, I ask you to please remember to pray for all the priests that live and serve at St. Luke parish, as well as for the special priests who ministered to you and your families over the years who have passed away and perhaps rely on your prayers to help them get to heaven. *St. John Vianney, pray for our priests!* 

In the gospel this weekend, we hear Jesus use parables as he describes the Kingdom of Heaven. May we treasure our hope for the Kingdom of Heaven like the pearl of great price; may we, in charity, do what is necessary to one day be welcomed into the special place prepared for us in the Kingdom!
