

Each of the synoptic gospels (Matthew, Mark, and Luke) recounts the Transfiguration of Jesus on Mount Tabor. This episode in the life of Jesus is so significant that the Church includes the Transfiguration in the liturgy two times every year: on the Second Sunday of Lent we hear one of the synoptic passages of the Transfiguration; then, on August 6, we celebrate the *Feast of the*

Transfiguration. When it falls on a Sunday, because it is a feast of the Lord, it replaces the Ordinary Time Sunday so we can reflect on this important moment in the life of Christ. Jesus leads Peter, James, and John up Mount Tabor, and He is transfigured before them. Moses and Elijah, representing the Law and the Prophets, appear with Jesus, and Peter says, "Lord, it is good that we are here." As we celebrate the Transfiguration this weekend, may we humbly acknowledge that it is always good for us to be with one another in the Lord's presence. In a society that devalues the importance of community life and faith, may we always proudly gather as a faith community to manifest our oneness in the Lord.

On August 10, we celebrate the Feast of St. Lawrence, deacon and martyr. He was born in the early 3rd century, and as a deacon he was entrusted with the care of widows, orphans, and the poor. Tradition says that when he faced martyrdom, the emperor offered to spare Lawrence's life if he would hand over the "treasures of the Church." In response, Lawrence brought out the sick, the poor,



and the marginalized as the "treasures of the Church." He was martyred four days later by being placed on a gridiron over hot coals. Again, tradition says that, after suffering pain for a long time on the gridiron, he cheerfully said, "I'm well done on this side; turn me over." St. Lawrence is honored as the patron of deacons, chefs and firefighters. I use the feast of St. Lawrence as an opportunity to ask the men of our parish to prayerfully consider a vocation to be a deacon. Most deacons are married men, and so they bring the perspective of family life to their ministry in the community. While deacons certainly have a role in the sacred liturgy, their ministry is mostly about service to the poor and those in need. If anyone would like to discuss the vocation to the diaconate, I invite you to please contact me or speak with Deacon John Kramer.



I'm trying to watch the weather to see if I can plan an outdoor session for Eucharistic Adoration like we did last year. It was a beautiful evening, and it was nice to see people who were simply going for a walk come over to spend some time before the Blessed Sacrament by Our Lady's grotto. Especially as the Church is promoting a Eucharistic Revival to renew all the faithful in the power of Jesus in the Eucharist,

I think it is important for us to provide opportunities for people to spend some time with the Lord. Watch the bulletin, our Facebook page, and Flocknote for notifications.




