

Sabato Addeo Anna Sarosi Dear Friends,

An older parishioner told me recently that when she was on her way into church, people from a car called out to her asking for assistance. She prudently did not approach the car and went into church. I encourage everyone to please be careful in your interactions with strangers, especially when you are alone. Also, it seems that every few weeks a parishioner will tell me they received an email or text message from me asking for emergency assistance. I will NEVER, EVER send a text or email asking for assistance. People report getting calls from the "IRS" or "ConEd" demanding immediate payment with gift cards. These are all scams, and I encourage you to simply hang up when you receive such calls. "ConEd" called the rectory on a Saturday a couple of months ago threatening to turn off the electricity because we hadn't paid our bill. I hung up, and amazingly the lights stayed on! Please be careful when you receive such requests. If you have any doubt, hang up and call the phone number from your last invoice.

The fiscal year of the parish ends on August 31. As you know from your own household budgets, everything is more expensive. Our parish relies on charitable donations from parishioners. Pope Francis does not send money from the Vatican to offset our parish budget; nor does Bishop Brennan send us money from the Chancery in Brooklyn. Every parish is expected to be self-sustaining, and it is becoming more and more of a challenge. With an average weekly collection of \$10,000, we are barely able to meet our expenses. I have used this in the past to illustrate our situation: in six months, our average collection is \$260,000. Every year I receive a property insurance bill of about \$80,000; the diocesan assessment is about \$75,000; and our health insurance bills for clergy and employees comes to about \$140,000 over the course of the year. Those three bills alone come to over \$290,000! On top of those expenses, we have salaries for clergy and employees, electric bills, landscaping, office expenses, etc. Here is a snapshot of the envelopes that came in the collection on July 30, 2023:

In addition to the envelopes that were placed in the baskets, the loose cash and the Give Central donations for that weekend brought the total collection to \$9,758.00 – not quite the \$10,000 average weekly collection. I have made the personal decision to tithe for many years. It is not always easy, but I recognize many blessings from God in my life, and so tithing gives me a chance to make a return to the Lord for all the good He does for me. Please prayerfully consider increasing your weekly offering to our parish. I thank everyone for your generosity and support.
