#### Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Friends,

This is the last full week of August ... summer is quickly passing by. Vacations will transition to back-to-school sales, and I hope and pray that all our parishioners were able to enjoy some kind of break in their routines before summer comes to an end. In two weeks it will be Labor Day weekend, so enjoy the time that is left in Summer 2023!

The gospel this weekend is a tough one. It's hard to hear the Lord be so seemingly uncaring towards someone in need. The Canaanite woman's daughter is being tormented by a demon, and she believes that Jesus can help her: "Have pity on me Lord, Son of David." "It is not right to take the food of the children and throw it to the dogs," Jesus replies. When she persists, Jesus recognizes her great faith: "Let it be done for you as you wish." The grace of God is not earned by <u>any</u> of us; it is a free and generous gift. While Jesus was primarily sent to the Israelites, His ministry is open to all who have faith in Him. Once the woman demonstrates her faith, Jesus is more than willing to help her. We have to remember that simply possessing a baptismal certificate is no guarantee of faith. We need to develop and deepen a relationship with Jesus so we can manifest a living, personal and intimate faith in the Lord. Then, we can dare to entrust our needs to Him in the hope of having our prayers answered.

Last Tuesday we celebrated the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary; this Tuesday we celebrate the Queenship of Mary. When the Memorial was prescribed by Pope Pius XII in 1954, it was originally celebrated on May 31<sup>st</sup>. Now, it is fitting that it is celebrated on August 22<sup>nd</sup>, creating an Octave of the celebration of the Assumption. These two Marian celebrations mark the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> of the Glorious Mysteries of the Rosary. *To Jesus through Mary!* 

On Thursday, we celebrate the Feast of St. Bartholomew the Apostle. By tradition, he preached the gospel in India and Armenia, and he was put to death by flaying. As an apostle, he spent three years close to Jesus in His public ministry, and he was a witness to the Risen Christ. He received the gift of the Holy Spirit and Pentecost, and faithfully preached the Good News until his death. We wear red vestments when we celebrate the apostles (except John) to remember the blood they shed in witness to Jesus. We pray for their courage and strength as we give witness to our faith by our lives.

As you know, I was appointed by Bishop Brennan to be the Regional Episcopal Vicar of Queens East. Over the summer I have been dealing with some issues as they arose, and I look ahead to many meetings and events in the fall. On Wednesday, October 4, the other Vicars and I will be officially installed by Bishop Brennan at the Co-Cathedral of St. Joseph in Brooklyn. I ask for your prayers, your support, and your patience as I take on this new role. I will try my best to remain engaged in parish life, but it will be a bit of a balancing act from time to time. As always, pray for vocations ... the harvest is plenty, but laborers are few!

Finally, we wish Bishop Chappetto a very happy birthday today. Your pastor turns 60 tomorrow ... old age begins!
