Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time

August 27, 2023

Dear Friends,

Last weekend Callistus returned safely to NY and is back at St. Joseph Seminary in Yonkers to continue his studies and formation for the priesthood. Several parishioners were asking about him, and so I thought I would let everyone know here in the bulletin. Please continue to keep him in your prayers.

I posted on the parish Facebook page that Fr. Nicholas Colalella took his First Vows as a Jesuit on August 12th. The ceremony took place at the Immaculate Conception Cathedral in Syracuse, NY. Our parish and diocese were blessed by his service and ministry, and so we thank God that he continues to discern God's call to religious life. Let us pray for the intercession of St. Ignatius Loyola for him and for all considering a call to the Society of Jesus.

In the gospel this weekend we hear about the primacy of St. Peter. Jesus asks, "Who do you say that I am?" Peter responds, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Then Jesus declares, "Upon this rock I will build my church." In art, St. Peter is usually depicted holding the keys of the kingdom, and the Vatican flag has two keys crossed below the Papal tiara to show the authority of the Pope as the Successor of St. Peter. As you know, I lived in Rome for 10 years. I had the opportunity to meet Pope St. John Paul II several times over the years, and I had the privilege of meeting Pope Benedict XVI during the *ad limina* visit of the New York State bishops. On March 13, 2013, I was in St. Peter's Square to see the white smoke that announced the election of Pope Francis, and I received his first blessing from the balcony of St. Peter's Basilica. As Catholics, we pray for the Holy Father every time we celebrate Mass, and we trust that he guides the Church with the grace of the Holy Spirit. Let us pray for Pope Francis, that the Lord will continue to give him the grace and strength to continue to lead the Church as the Vicar of Christ on earth.



Because today is Sunday, the feast of St. Monica is not celebrated at the liturgy, but she is undoubtedly an important figure from the early days of the Church. Her son, St. Augustine, is celebrated on August 28th, and he was certainly the reason for Monica to shed many tears and offer many prayers. Her efforts were not in vain, for she saw not only the conversion of her son, but he also became a

great bishop and doctor of the Church. I always recommend the intercession of St. Monica to mothers who are concerned about the faith of their children.

On Tuesday, we will celebrate the Passion of St. John the Baptist. He was the forerunner of Jesus, the voice crying out in the wilderness. Jesus joined the crowds at the Jordan River and was baptized by John, thereby beginning his public ministry. From that point forward, John "decreased" so Jesus could "increase," and he ultimately was beheaded. Let us follow



the example of St. John - to live humbly as disciples of the Lord, and to be willing to share in His cross in our daily lives.
