Dear Friends,

Last weekend Bishop Chappetto blessed the new church doors at the noon Mass. You will find photos in today's bulletin. I only knew Frank Morelli for a short time before he died, but I always found a warm welcome whenever I went to the house for a visit or to anoint Frank or bring him Communion. After his death, Claudia asked to make a gift to St. Luke in memory of Frank; when I mentioned the new doors she didn't hesitate for a moment. Both Frank and Claudia welcomed so many people to their home over the years, and so having doors in memory of Frank is such an appropriate way to remember the Morelli family. I thank Claudia Morelli for providing the new doors for our beautiful church, and for the luncheon that followed the Mass!

A couple of weeks ago we had a beautiful evening of Eucharistic Adoration outdoors by the grotto of our Blessed Mother behind the rectory. Several parishioners asked if we could do it again before the summer ends. As I look at the forecast for this coming week, it looks like Tuesday will be another beautiful evening, so I'd like to offer the opportunity for adoration once again. It will give us an opportunity to pray as we begin a new pastoral year, and as the children of our community return to school for a new academic year. Please join us for some special time in prayer before the Lord.

Now that Labor Day weekend is here, remember that the Sunday 5:00 PM Mass will return next weekend on September 10th. Also, at all Masses next weekend, we will bless backpacks for ALL STUDENTS returning to school this fall: St. Luke School, Public School, High School – all students are invited to bring their backpacks for a blessing for the new school year. Finally, the rectory office will return to regular office hours on Fridays. Of course, on Monday, the office will be closed for Labor Day, and Mass on Monday will be celebrated at 9:30 AM.

Every summer, the Propagation of the Faith Office of the diocese arranges for mission appeals to take place in our parishes so we can hear about missionary activity in other places around the world and help to support the work financially and with our prayers. Next weekend (September 9/10) at all the Saturday evening and Sunday Masses we will welcome a representative from the Little Sisters of St. Francis of Assisi who will speak about the work done by their community. We will take up a collection on their behalf and then forward it to the Propagation of the Faith. Since there is no envelope, the ushers will pass through the church a second time to accept your cash donations. If you plan on making out a check, please make it out to St. Luke, since we deposit the money here and then make a check for the Propagation of the Faith for the whole amount. Thank you in advance for your generous response.

In last weekend's gospel, Simon was called "the rock" upon which Jesus would build the Church. This week, just five verses later, Jesus says to Peter: "Get behind me, Satan! You are an obstacle to me." Jesus then explains to the apostles: "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me." Every disciple throughout salvation history has had to come to terms about the reality of the cross in our lives. May the Lord strengthen all of us as we carry the cross.




Everyone's welcoming kindness made us feel right at home. We met some very generous individuals; old friendships have been rekindled, and some new friendships have been forged.
