#### Twenty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Friends,

The new pastoral year has begun! The school opened on Wednesday, and it seems that we are off to a good start. It was a little muggy and buggy on Tuesday night, but about 25 people gathered in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament, so we have much to be thankful for here at St. Luke. We pray that the Lord will bless our parish through the intercession of our patron, St. Luke, as we begin this new year.

Our parish has had the annual custom of joining with St. Mel parish to celebrate Saint Padre Pio. His feast day is September 23<sup>rd</sup>, and so we will have a procession and Mass on Friday, September 22<sup>nd</sup>. The procession will start at St. Mel at 6:30 PM, and Mass will be celebrated when the procession arrives at St. Luke, around 7:30 PM. I thank Fr. Fonti for his collaboration in this effort. St. Mel has a parish event scheduled for this coming Friday, and the rain date for it is September 22<sup>nd</sup>. As of this writing, it looks like the weather should cooperate, but we may provide updates if we need to make changes. On Sunday, September 24<sup>th</sup>, after the Blood Drive, there will be a Dinner/Dance in honor of Padre Pio. The proceeds from the event will be sent to the hospital established by Padre Pio at San Giovanni Rotondo in Italy. I hope many people will participate to make both these events successful!

Although it seems like COVID cases are currently increasing, the pandemic is over and, while some of the more vulnerable among us need to be careful in their interactions with others, parish life is more or less back to normal. Is there any interest in fund-raisers and fun -raisers? I'd love to see events like parish dances, Radio Bingo, maybe even "Whitestone's Got Talent," but we need volunteers to come forward to help coordinate events like these. If you'd like to work on events like these for the parish, please let me know.

This weekend we hear a passage from the 18<sup>th</sup> chapter of Matthew's gospel proclaimed at Mass: "For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them." For Catholics, our faith can sometimes feel private and very personal, but Jesus called the apostles and disciples to be a *community* of faith. Of course, our own personal prayer life is very important, and we can have a very intimate experience of the Lord when we pray, but Jesus also promises to be with us when two or more of us are gathered in his name. It is so vitally important for us to gather with one another each week and to support one another with our prayers and our presence.

On Thursday this week, the Church celebrates the *Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross*. St. Helena was the mother of the Emperor, Constantine the Great. She lived at the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> and beginning of the 4<sup>th</sup> centuries, and once she became a Christian, she was tasked with locating the relics of Christian tradition. This feast celebrates two events: St. Helena discovering the relic of the true cross of Jesus, and Constantine erecting a church, shrine, and basilica to mark the place of the empty tomb and the place where Jesus was crucified on Calvary. *Lord, save us by Your Holy Cross!*






