

Thomas J. Fried Anna Speranza Dear Friends,

The gospel for today's Mass is one of those passages that is often disturbing to people: "It's not fair that those who only worked a couple of hours are getting the same pay as those who toiled in the sun all day!" I bet that many of you reading this have at some point in your life agreed wholeheartedly with those words. Jesus might respond, "You are not thinking like God, but rather by human standards." As you know, Jesus often used ordinary images in his parables so that his hearers could be led to a more profound understanding of God. How does the parable begin? "The kingdom of heaven is like a landowner" Jesus is using the human experience of a landowner and workers to teach about heaven. There are people who are lifelong, faithful Christians ... is their heaven "better" than the heaven for those who converted later in life? Some Catholics stray away from the practice of their faith and live "sinful" lives for years, and later in life are reconciled to the Church and return to the practice of their faith. Do they go to an inferior section of heaven when they die? Jesus teaches that heaven is heaven, and our merciful and loving God is generous in welcoming the greatest of saints and those who perhaps had many more struggles in their faith along the way to enjoy the fullness of eternal life in the kingdom.

On Wednesday this week we celebrate the Memorial of St. Vincent de Paul. He co-founded the Congregation of the Missions, also known as the Vincentians. One of our own sons from St. Luke, Fr. Kevin Creagh, CM, is a Vincentian priest. St. Vincent was a priest in the early 1600s who at first dedicated his life to the poor. Later, he dedicated himself to conducting retreats for clergy at a time when the morality among priests was waning. He also had a passion for the proper formation of seminarians for the priesthood, and so was involved in seminary education. Bishop Chappetto is among many priests from his generation who were formed for the priesthood by the Vincentians at Our Lady of Angels Seminary in Albany. St. Vincent also founded a religious community of women called the Daughters of Charity. In our community, we are most familiar with St. Vincent de Paul through the trucks that come twice a year to collect new and slightly used clothing. Also, St. John's University was established by the Vincentians, and many local people in our community have benefitted from an education there.

On Friday, we celebrate the Archangels: Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael. You will notice that each of their names ends with "el," which is a Hebrew word for God. Gabriel, of course, announced to Mary that she was chosen by God to be the Mother of Jesus. Gabriel is known as the "Might of God" and is the herald of the mysteries of God. Michael means "Who is like God?" and is seen as a commander and a guardian of the faith. Raphael means "God heals" and is mentioned in reference to Tobit in the Old Testament. The celebration of the archangels gives us the chance to remember and pray for Fr. Paul Kim and the people of St. Raphael parish.

Next weekend we will welcome the group from the Holy Land who will sell olivewood statues and other artwork to support the small community of Christians that remain in Bethlehem. Please note that the date and time for the Padre Pio Dinner Dance has been changed to October 7th. Finally, on October 8th, the Youth Group will sponsor a Pancake Breakfast. Please plan on supporting them!
