

Twenty-Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

October 01, 2023

Dear Friends,

On Wednesday this week, Bishop Brennan will celebrate Mass at the Co-Cathedral of St. Joseph to install new Regional Episcopal Vicars for the Diocese of Brooklyn. As you know, I am the Regional Vicar for Queens East, which encompasses Whitestone, Flushing, Bayside, Douglaston, Cambria Heights, Rosedale, and through the Rockaways. I meet regularly with the bishop and other vicars, attend deanery meetings, Assignment Board meetings, Presbyteral Council meetings, and deal with situations as they arise with parishes and priests. I thank you for your prayers and support, and appreciate your patience as I continue to balance my diocesan responsibilities with my parish duties.

Since the installation will take place on the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi, we will bless animals on Tuesday, October 3rd at 4:00 PM. Actually, the other benefit is that the children in our Religious Education Program have class on Wednesday afternoon; by blessing on the Eve of his feast, it gives those children a chance to bring their pets for a blessing. We look forward to seeing our furry parishioners on Tuesday!

Our gospel passage today focuses on doing the Father's will. It's easy to say, "yes;" the challenge is to actually do what is asked of us. We often hear the word *vocation* as a way to describe our call as disciples. I would suggest that there are "Vocations" and "vocations." Vocations are our lifelong calls to priesthood, diaconate, consecrated life ... even the life of dedicated service offered by single people. On the other hand, vocations are the daily opportunities we are given to show charity, kindness, and mercy to our brothers and sisters. In our lifelong Vocations, sometimes we get tired and have a hard time remaining faithful. In our day-to-day opportunities to respond to God's call, sometimes we say, "yes" and sometimes we say, "no." The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak! Every week when we gather for worship to hear God's Word and be nourished by Jesus in the Eucharist, we are renewed and strengthened in our commitment to discipleship. Please God, let our "yes" be "YES!"

Because October 1st falls on a Sunday this year, we do not celebrate the memorial of St. Therese of Lisieux, the Little Flower, but we certainly can pray for her intercession. It's amazing that this young woman who died at an early age in a cloister in a remote part of France is known and beloved all over the world. Her "Little Way" has inspired countless people to come to know and love God in a very special way. I recommend *The Story of A Soul*, her spiritual autobiography, to all parishioners. It's a simple read, but so profound and inspirational. Not only is Therese a saint, but her parents, Zelie and Louis, were also canonized saints in 2015 by Pope Francis. What a remarkable family! May their intercession assist the families here at St. Luke!

Next Saturday, the Church celebrates Our Lady of the Rosary. So many parishioners find great comfort and many blessings by praying the Rosary and being brought to Jesus through Mary. On our parish feast day, the students of St. Luke School will come to church for a Rosary Rally to ask for Mary's special intercession on our community. This simple devotion has such great power. Pray the Rosary!
