Twenty-Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Friends,

I thank you for your prayers and support as I was installed as Regional Episcopal Vicar this past week. Several parishioners were able to come to the magnificent Co-Cathedral of St. Joseph, and many more watched on NET TV. We pray for God's continued blessings on our bishop, our diocese, and on our parish. Fr. Krlis has been away on retreat; we pray for him as we are assured of his prayers for all of us.

It seems like we can't get out of the vineyard! Once again this weekend, Jesus uses the image of a vineyard in one of his parables. This time, the workers in the vineyard don't want to provide the landowner with his proper portion of the crop at harvest time, and so they beat and stone and kill his servants. When he sends his son, he presumes they will accept his authority, but they decide to kill him, too, in hopes that they will now gain his inheritance. The parable tells the story of the Hebrew Scriptures. God sent the prophets to remind his chosen people of their commitment to the covenant; as we know, the prophets were not always accepted by the people, and many were made to suffer, some even to the point of death. When God sent His Son, He, too, was rejected by the people and ultimately was nailed to the cross: *the stone rejected by the builders has become the cornerstone*. Even in our day, people reject the Lord. We need to heed God's warning and become disciples who will bear fruit for the kingdom.

October is Italian Heritage month, and Monday is Columbus Day, and so, as a parish community, we celebrate the heritage of so many people in our community who trace their roots back to Italy. Of course, every community in Brooklyn and Queens is a multi-cultural community, and so we respect and interact with people from many different backgrounds even here in Whitestone. As Christians, we strive to live out the desire of Jesus that we may all be one in Christ.

Next weekend our Youth Group will host a pancake breakfast for our community. It is always a fun event and gives us an opportunity to support our young people. Please plan on participating in the event next Sunday morning.

Also next weekend, our parish choir will present a concert in honor of the Eucharistic Revival taking place in the Church: **FESTIVAL OF HYMNS & SONGS OF PRAISE: Hymns & Anthems in Praise of the Holy Eucharist.** We are blessed to have Jessica Tranzillo-Smith as our director of music, along with Loneda Jautakiene, our parish organist. Together with the volunteer members of the choir, they help us to "pray twice" as we raise our voices in song to the Lord. I have no doubt that the concert will be beautiful and inspiring and uplifting. Please plan on attending and bring friends and neighbors with you!

The diocese is hosting a liturgical minister training session at Resurrection-Ascension parish in Rego Park in December. If you are discerning the possibility of becoming a minister, please call me so we can speak.
