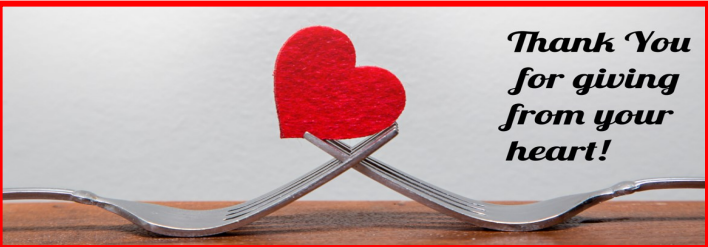

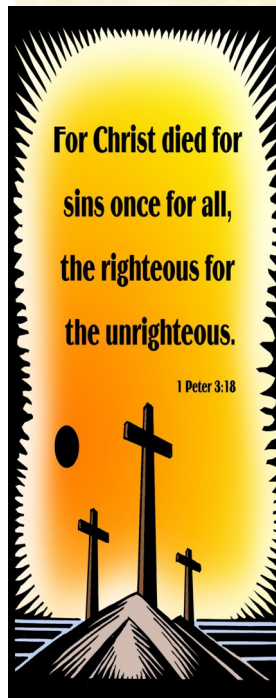

Sacramental Celebrations in October

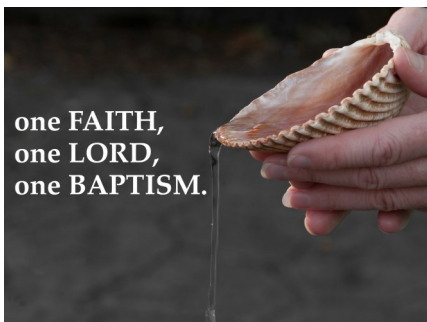
