Dear Friends,

Because of the deadline for Thanksgiving, I am writing this before the weekend, so I cannot share the Mass attendance numbers for November 18/19 in this bulletin. This weekend we celebrate *Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe*, formerly known as *Christ the King*. This solemnity brings us to the final week of the liturgical year, so next weekend is the First Sunday of Advent. Since Christmas falls on a Monday this year, we have the shortest possible Advent of preparation ... in the morning of December 24th, we will celebrate the Fourth Sunday of Advent, and in the afternoon we will celebrate Christmas Eve. Brace yourselves ... Christmas will be here before you know it!

Our last encounter with Matthew's Gospel as this liturgical year comes to an end is a really beautiful passage from chapter 25. Jesus is teaching his disciples about the end times. Are we sheep or are we goats? "Whatever you did for one of the least brothers of mine, you did for me.... what you did not do for one of these least ones, you did not do for me." This is one of those teachings that hits us right between the eyes. Many saints teach that we should see Christ in the faces of the poor and needy. When we do, we are moved to love and compassion, and we willingly and generously serve. If we fail to see Christ in others, it is too easy to ignore their needs and pass them by. This message is timeless, and we are often humbled when we recall the times when we failed to serve Christ in our needy brothers and sisters. Perhaps some will find that the opportunity to celebrate the Sacrament of Penance soon before the year ends will be a great way to reorient our hearts to serve others in imitation of Christ.

Now that Thanksgiving is over, preparations for Christmas will keep many of us busy. Try to find ways to keep Christ in Christmas. If you still send out Christmas cards, choose to buy the religious Christmas stamps. The USPS usually provides a beautiful image of Mary and Jesus on Christmas stamps each year, and it becomes a subtle and meaningful way to share Jesus with others. Pray for your family and friends as you write your cards or do your shopping. If you bake for Christmas, consider preparing a small plate of goodies for an elderly neighbor who lives alone and would love to have a visit during the holidays. Don't forget those who have lost loved ones ... reach out to them with a text or a call or a note to reassure them that you haven't forgotten their grief and hope to comfort them with your love and prayers.

Speaking of Christmas, we will have the lighting of the parish Christmas tree after the 5:00 PM Mass next Saturday. It's always a fun event. Our Children's Choir will sing, the Martha's Ministry ladies will provide hot chocolate, and the lights help to create the mood for this holy season. I am grateful to everyone for helping to make Christmas so special here at St. Luke.


