Although there are four Sundays of Advent, the season is only three weeks long this year because the Fourth Sunday of Advent falls on Christmas Eve. This third Sunday of Advent is known as *Gaudete Sunday*. We rejoice because our time of waiting is almost fulfilled. This week we turn to John's Gospel for his perspective on John the Baptist: "A man named John was sent from God. He came for testimony, to testify to the light, so that all might believe through him. He was not the light, but came to testify to the light." As we light the third candle on the Advent wreath this weekend, the light begins to grow as we anticipate the celebration of the birth of God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God.

Monday, December 18th is **Reconciliation Monday**. Most parishes in the Archdiocese of New York and the Diocese of Brooklyn will have priests available for confession from 2 to 4 PM and 6 to 9 PM, but I encourage you to check with any parish to verify their schedule. Included in today's bulletin is the schedule of confessions for parishes in our deanery. Here at St. Luke, we typically provide the opportunity for confession immediately after the noon Mass, and then again in the evening with Eucharistic Adoration and Benediction. Please share the schedule with family members, neighbors, and friends who may wish to celebrate the Sacrament of Penance in preparation for Christmas. What a great gift to give to ourselves as we prepare to celebrate the Birth of Jesus!

Several parishioners have asked about Mass next weekend. We will celebrate Mass for the Fourth Sunday of Advent on Saturday evening at 5:00 PM, and then Sunday morning at 7:30 AM, 9:00 AM (Italian), 10:30 AM and 12:00 PM. Later in the afternoon, we will begin our celebration of Christmas. On Christmas Eve, we will celebrate Mass at 4:00 PM (a Mass for children with the reenactment of the Nativity scene by the children), 6:00 PM, and at 10:00 PM (this Mass will be preceded by Christmas carols by our choir). On Christmas Day, Mass will be celebrated at 9:00 AM (Italian), 10:30 AM and 12:00 PM. You can choose any Mass for the Fourth Sunday of Advent to fulfill your Sunday obligation, and then any of the Christmas Masses to fulfill your obligation for Mass on the holyday. If you choose to go to an early Mass on the 24th for the Fourth Sunday of Advent, and then an afternoon or evening Mass for Christmas, you may receive the Eucharist at both celebrations even though it is the same day. It will be a busy weekend for sure, but I look forward to seeing parishioners, neighbors and friends as we celebrate Christmas this year!

In November, our longtime custodian, Antonino Bongiorno, decided to accept a new opportunity for employment. We are grateful for his years of service to St. Luke, and we wish him all the best in his new endeavors. Earlier this month, Damian Scardamaglia, a parishioner, and the husband of Lisa Scardamaglia, who works with Sr. Katherine in the religious education office, began working as our new custodian. Damian has a long history with our parish and has coordinated many volunteer efforts as a parishioner and with the Knights of Columbus over the years. We welcome him in his new role as parish custodian!
