

This is quite a weekend! Until midday Sunday we celebrate the Fourth Sunday of Advent, and then we switch to our celebrations for Christmas on Sunday afternoon through Monday morning. It will be quite a workout for all of us who are liturgical ministers in the parish, but what a great blessing to join together to celebrate the Birth of Jesus. On behalf of all the parish staff, I extend a warm welcome to neighbors, friends, and visitors who are joining us this weekend. I pray that you always feel at home here at St. Luke, and that your time with family and friends will be a great blessing for you.

On the Fourth Sunday of Advent we finally come upon Mary at the Annunciation. The angel Gabriel is sent by God to announce his plan: "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God." Luke records for us Mary's generous and loving response: "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word." Mary's response to God's call is a model for all Christians. Whether we feel called to a vocation to priesthood, diaconate, or consecrated life, or if we believe God is calling us to marriage and family life, or even to a single life of service, we are called to humbly make ourselves available to God's will, trusting that the Lord, who has begun this good work in us, will bring it to fulfillment.

There are several liturgical options for the celebration of Christmas: the Vigil Mass, the Mass during the Night, the Mass at Dawn, and the Mass during the Day. At the first three Masses, we hear parts of the familiar story of the Birth of Jesus. At the Vigil Mass, Matthew recounts the genealogy of Jesus from Abraham to David to Joseph, the husband of Mary, and then we hear Joseph's role in the Birth of Jesus. At the Mass during the Night, Luke tells us of the journey of Joseph and Mary to Bethlehem, where Jesus was born in a stable and laid in a manger because there was no room for them in the inn. Then, the angels announce to the shepherds the good news of great joy, and they sing God's glory on high. During the Mass at Dawn, Luke continues to tell how, when the angels went away from the shepherds to heaven, the shepherds went to Bethlehem to see for themselves. They told Mary and Joseph what had been told them about the child, and Mary kept all these things, reflecting on them in her heart. At the Mass during the Day, we turn to the first chapter of John's gospel. He doesn't record any of the details of the birth of Jesus, but he gets right to the meaning of this great event: "the Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. "At whatever Mass you attend, and with whatever Scripture passages you hear proclaimed, may you be renewed in the great joy of the Birth of Jesus, and may you carry that message with you so that others may come to know the great gift that was given to the world with the Birth of Jesus.

On behalf of all the clergy and staff of St. Luke Parish, I extend to all of you our prayers and best wishes as you celebrate Christmas with your family and friends.


Collective Intentions Masses

Although the Eucharist appears to be simple bread and wine, it is actually the "source and summit" of the Christian life.

Presence: The Mystery of

the Eucharist explores the truth and beauty of Christ's real presence in the Eucharist, from its origins in Sacred Scripture to its profound role in the life of the Church and its members. The Eucharist is the crescendo of the entire story of salvation.

St. John, Apostle & Evangelist

Feast day, Dec. 27th

St. John the Apostle, the son of Zebedee and Salome, was one the Twelve Apostles of Jesus. John was called to be an Apostle by our Lord in in the first year of His public ministry. John is believed to be the longest living apostle and the only not to a martyr's death.

John was the only one of the Twelve who did not forsake the Savior in the hour of His Passion. He stood faithfully at the cross when the Savior made him the guardian of His Mother.

The "beloved disciple" died in Ephesus after AD98.

St. John is the parton saint of love, loyalty, friendships, and authors. He is often depicted in art as the author of the Gospel with an eagle, symbolizing "the height he rose to in his gospel." In other icons, he is shown looking up into heaven and dictating his Gospel to his disciple.
