

I pray that everyone had a Happy and Healthy beginning to the New Year. The Church has us celebrate the Epiphany this weekend. The Magi followed the star and found the child wrapped in swaddling clothes laying in the manger. They brought their gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh, which symbolize that Jesus was a king (gold), a priest (frankincense) and one who would die (myrrh). The wise men or astrologers themselves represent the fact that Jesus was born not just to save Israel, but that his salvation would be open to all people. On Monday, the Christmas season officially comes to an end with the celebration of the Baptism of the Lord.

Many of you have encountered Sr. Anne in the rectory office on Monday mornings. For years she has volunteered in our office to help with the door and the phones. Just before Christmas she informed me that she will no longer be able to come on Monday mornings. I want to take this opportunity to thank Sr. Anne for her kindness through the years, and we wish her well in her "retirement." I also want to take this opportunity to thank Jane Cazzorla for her generous service to the parish over these past few months. She was a great help in the rectory office, and she continues to help in the sacristy for weekday Masses and funerals, along with Christine Kromer and Anthony D'Amato. We are truly blessed with so many people who help behind the scenes here at St. Luke!

There is an ancient custom to announce the moveable feasts of the upcoming liturgical year at the celebration of the Epiphany:

Know, dear brothers and sisters, that, as we have rejoiced at the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, so by leave of God's mercy we announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection, who is our Savior. On the fourteenth day of February will fall Ash Wednesday,

and the beginning of the fast of the most sacred Lenten season.

On the thirty-first day of March you will celebrate with joy Easter Day,

the Paschal feast of our Lord Jesus Christ.

On the ninth day of May will be the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ.

On the nineteenth day of May, the feast of Pentecost.

On the second day of June, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

On the first day of December, the First Sunday of the Advent of our Lord Jesus Christ,

to whom is honor and glory for ever and ever. Amen.

As we return to Ordinary Time this week, we ask the Lord to help us in our resolve to be better Christians. We pray for parents and godparents, that they may be faithful in their duty to be the first teachers of their children in the practice of the faith. We pray for those who are seeking the Lord, that they may one day be fully initiated in the faith. We pray for those who do not regularly practice the faith, that God's grace may bring them back to the Church to worship with the community regularly and to avail themselves of God's love and forgiveness, which he so generously gives to those who seek Him.
