With the celebration of the Baptism of the Lord last Monday, we are now officially in the Ordinary Time of the Church year. On this Second Sunday in Ordinary Time, God’s call is the focus for our reflection. In the first reading from the first book of Samuel, Samuel doesn’t immediately recognize that God is calling him. When Eli finally figures out what is happening with Samuel, he instructs the young man to respond to God’s call by saying, “Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening.” With that, we are told that Samuel grew up and the Lord was with him. In our passage from John’s gospel this weekend, John the Baptist decreases so Jesus can increase. John identifies Jesus as the Lamb of God, and the disciples follow Jesus and are invited: “Come and you will see.” In our lives as disciples, we engage the Lord in prayer so we can hear His call to holiness. This same call is manifested in many ways. Some of us respond to the Lord’s call and choose to become priests or deacons; others follow the Lord in religious or consecrated life; many people choose married life and give witness to their commitment to one another and their openness to having children to help the Church to grow; still others remain single and find many ways to serve the Lord by serving their brothers and sisters. The spirit of our response to the Lord is found in the responsorial psalm for today’s Mass: “Here I am, Lord; I come to do your will.” As we begin this new year of grace, may we always make ourselves available whenever and however God calls.

On Monday this week, our nation celebrates Martin Luther King, Jr. Day. Many of us remember the Civil Rights Movement of the 1950s and 1960s. Although the Emancipation Proclamation was signed by President Lincoln on January 1, 1863, the vestiges of prejudice continued to influence our society, and figures like Martin Luther King, Jr., emerged to promote respect and dignity for all people, not based on the color of their skin but on the content of their character. Our world and our nation still suffer from the reality of prejudice and oppression not only based on skin color, but also on religious expression, age, sexual identity, and a host of other factors. As Christians, we are reminded of the importance of the words of St. Paul to the Galatians: *“For all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free person, there is not male and female: for you are all one in Christ Jesus. And if you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham’s descendant, heirs according to the promise”* (Gal. 3:27-29).

We welcome Fr. Michael Drea to St. Luke this weekend. Fr. Drea is a priest of the Archdiocese of Boston but has been involved with ministering to Catholic students on college campuses for many years. The Fellowship of Catholic University Students (FOCUS) serves in our diocese at Queens College, but almost 1,000 FOCUS missionaries are present on over 232 campuses to help engage college students in a relationship with Christ and His Church so they are equipped for a lifetime of Catholic evangelization. Many parents and grandparents speak of their concern for the life of faith for the children and grandchildren. I pray that our support of FOCUS will help the young members of our parish and our families to embrace the life of faith and commit themselves to spreading the Good News of Jesus to their peers.
