Dear Friends,



For fifty years now, the Church in the United States celebrates Catholic Schools Week to highlight the value of a Catholic education in our community, in our diocese, and in our nation. This year and through 2026, the theme for Catholic Schools Week is "Catholic Schools: United in Faith and Community." Last week the Church marked a week of Prayer for Christian Unity to highlight Jesus' prayer that we all might be one. While it is certainly true that different

Catholic Schools Christian ecclesial communities should strive to work together to find unifying United in Faith and Community elements that can bring us closer together in Christ, even more so should we strive to practice what we preach and teach as Catholics. I have often said that a Catholic School building does not make sense unless it builds a strong bridge to the regular practice of the faith in our churches. Parents accept their primary role of forming their children in the practice of the faith at baptism. The Church promises to assist parents to fulfill that responsibility through our Catholic Schools and Religious Education programs. It wouldn't make sense for parents to enroll their children in a dance class and never have them practice dance, or to enroll their children in baseball and never have them practice baseball. It does not make sense for parents to baptize their children and enroll children in a Catholic School and then not teach them to practice the faith. I believe that the theme "United in Faith and Community" tries to emphasize that learning about the faith and being part of a worshipping community go hand in hand. I pray that St. Luke School will become a more vibrant place where children are not only formed in the Catholic faith, but that they also proudly and with great dedication choose to practice their faith both in church on Sundays but also in their commitment to love God and love their neighbor.

We cannot properly celebrate Catholic Schools Week without acknowledging the leadership and sacrifices of our faculty and staff at St. Luke School. I know that our parishioners, especially the parents and students of St. Luke School, join me in expressing our gratitude to Mrs. Brunswick, Mrs. Mezic, and all the teachers, aides and staff that allow St. Luke to be an outstanding school that fosters academic excellence and the living of our Catholic faith. Of course, we are also grateful for the support and sacrifices of the parents and our benefactors. We pray that God will continue to shower His blessings upon all of us as we celebrate Catholic Schools Week!

Our gospel today is appropriate for Catholic Schools Week. Jesus goes into the synagogue in Capernaum on the sabbath. For the Jewish people, the synagogue is a place for worship and learning. The Jewish people would look to their rabbis to learn about the Torah (the law) and the prophets so that they could be God's faithful and chosen people. Like all teachers, rabbis establish their authority by their ability to teach others from what they learned in the studies. Jesus not only manifests His authority by His teaching, but also by His ability to cast out the unclean spirit from the man who had been possessed. In a similar way, as we learn

more about Jesus and try to become more like Him, we manifest our faith in our desire to do good and to avoid sin and evil.
