This is the last full week before Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 14<sup>th</sup>. While *Mardi Gras* is certainly part of the culture just before Lent, it's also good to spend some time preparing ourselves for the forty days of prayer, fasting and almsgiving that will soon be upon us. How should I balance penitential practices (what should I give up?) and opportunities for grace (more time for prayer and charitable acts)? Hopefully as we mature in our life of faith, Lent is more about spiritual growth and maturity than about missing out on things we enjoy because we have to give them up for Lent.

I am happy to announce that we received word that Deacon John Kramer will no longer split his ministry between Holy Trinity and St. Luke, but is now full assigned to St. Luke Parish. I pray that his presence among us will inspire

other men in our community to consider a vocation to the diaconate.

Update on the bell repairs ... the parts were ordered and have been delivered. The Verdin Company is scheduled to come here on February 29<sup>th</sup> to make the repairs. You may notice that the bell can still "toll" ... it just can't "swing." Once again, I thank all those who contributed to defray the cost of the repairs. I am glad that our bell should be fully functional in time for Easter!

I have spoken about the possibility of a parish pilgrimage in the past. I have known Gina & Achille Dilibero for almost 20 years, and I have joined them on pilgrimages to Italy, Medjugorje, and the Holy Land. They asked me to join them on a pilgrimage to Italy this coming fall. Basic information is contained in the bulletin, and more details will be available soon. I know several people have talked about the Holy Land, but, of course, the current situation in the Middle East prevents travel to that part of the world for the time being. I hope that some parishioners will consider joining this pilgrimage. Please send an email to office@stlukewhitestone.org if you are interested, and I will send you the flyer as soon as all the details are finalized.

There are a couple of more memorial opportunities. We have a fair number of funeral Masses that take place after cremation. When the cremated remains are brought to church, they are usually in a box or an urn, and we currently place the cremains on a table. There is a special receptacle called an ossuary that is designed to hold any container of cremated remains for services that take place at church. An ossuary and table costs about \$4,200.00, so 21 donations of \$200.00 will defray the cost and provide for a worthy receptacle for cremated remains for funerals here at St. Luke. I also purchased a more portable holy water bucket for use in the church. The memorial offering is \$750.00. Please contact me at the rectory if you are interested.

On this Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time, we continue to read from the first chapter of Mark's gospel. Jesus is still in Capernaum. After spending time in the synagogue, he goes to Peter's house, where Peter's mother-in-law is sick with a fever. Jesus grasped her by the hand and helped her up, and she began to wait on them. Later that evening the whole town was gathered at the door looking to be healed by Jesus. Instead of remaining in Capernaum, Jesus goes from town to town and village to village to preach and to heal. He does not limit his ministry to one town, but he makes himself available to whoever needs Him. Even now, Jesus is willing to serve wherever He is needed.
