Every year we recall the Transfiguration on the Second Sunday of Lent. Jesus ascends Mount Tabor with Peter, James, and John, and they see Jesus become dazzling white as Moses and Elijah appear alongside Him. We know that Jesus fulfills the law and the prophets, and so, as disciples, we strive to respond to our call to holiness every day, especially during the season of Lent. May our acts of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving help us to grow in God's grace so that our journey through Lent will lead us to the joyful celebration of the Resurrection.

St. Luke Parish is privileged to be a host of the diocesan Lenten Pilgrimage that is making its way through Brooklyn and Queens

during the Forty Days. Tomorrow – Monday, February 26th – people from all over the diocese will join us for prayer and reflection as our church will remain open throughout the day to welcome all who wish to take part in the pilgrimage. The schedule begins with the Angelus and Mass at Noon. After Mass, the Eucharist will remain exposed on the altar throughout the day, with times for prayer like the Rosary, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, and Evening Prayer. The day will conclude with a Holy Hour beginning at 6:30 PM and benediction at 7:30 PM. Please see the details of our day in the bulletin and let me know if you can help with hospitality to proudly welcome people from around the diocese to St. Luke.

An important aspect for this time of year is the celebration of the sacraments of initiation. Since Easter is usually the time for the full initiation of adults into the Catholic faith, we do not schedule baptisms during Lent to focus on the Forty Days as a time of preparation for the sacrament. Of course, in case of emergency, baptism will always be provided. This week, our young people preparing for First Holy Communion will receive the Sacrament of Penance for the first time. Of course, Lent is a time for many people to seek reconciliation with the Lord through the sacrament, especially on Reconciliation Monday, which will be celebrated on March 25 this year. After Easter, we will have celebrations of First Communion and Confirmation for our young people, and some adults will be prepared for Confirmation at Pentecost. We have no adults to be initiated in the faith this year at the Easter Vigil, but we are working together with St. Mel parish to share our resources to prepare adults for the sacraments next year. Let us pray for all those who will celebrate the Sacraments of Initiation this year!

Looking ahead, we have a celebration for St. Joseph planned for April 20th. The dinner-dance has grown over the past couple of years since the pandemic, and I hope even more people will participate this year. We need more opportunities for people to come together and enjoy time with one another.

Since this is Leap Year, we get an extra day of February this year. Best wishes to all the "Leap Babies" who get to celebrate their "real" birthday on February 29th this year!







Father Frank Tumino was ordained in June 1998 by the Most Reverend Thomas V Daily. He has served as a parochial vicar at Saint Sebastian, Woodside and Saint Gregory the Great in Bellerose. Father Tumino was appointed by Bishop Nicholas DiMarzio to serve as the Diocesan Director of Liturgy in February 2005 – 2014 succeeding Monsignor John C. Tosi. This full-time position became part-time when in 2009 he was named the Pastor of Saint Thomas the Apostle in Woodhaven, New York. In June of 2021, Fr. Tumino was appointed the Pastor of both Saint Augustine Parish and Saint Francis Xavier Parish in Park Slope Brooklyn. In addition, Fr. Tumino currently provides liturgical commentary on NET TV for the Masses associated with major Diocesan events.


