We were blessed this past week to host the diocesan Lenten Pilgrimage. The day began with Bishop Brennan joining St. Luke School for a "Holy Half Hour" of Eucharistic Adoration. Many people came to our church for prayer and reflection throughout the day, and it was a wonderful opportunity for St. Luke Parish to open our doors during this holy season to help our brothers and sisters enter into the spirit of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Thank you to everyone who participated and helped to make it such a special day.

As you know, since he became a senior priest about 10 years ago, Monsignor John Strynkowski has been a weekend assistant here at St. Luke. We have been blessed by his ministry, his preaching, and his

humble priestly example. A couple of years ago he moved out to Huntington and lives with a Polish community of religious sisters. We were happy to host his 60th anniversary as a priest in December, and he will soon celebrate his 85th birthday. He feels that it is time to "retire" once again, and so he will no longer come to St. Luke regularly as a weekend assistant. On behalf of our whole community, I extend to Monsignor Strynkowski our sincere gratitude for his ministry, and a promise of prayers for continued good health. In the spring we will have him return for a Mass of Thanksgiving, and we pray that he will be able to come back to St. Luke from time to time in the future.

If you come to the rectory, you may have been greeted by Sr. Joan Martin, OP. Sister Joan served for years as the Principal of St. Agnes High School. After she retired she has kept herself busy promoting Catholic education by serving Academy Boards as a member and as a mentor to other members. When she noticed that we currently have reduced hours in the rectory, she offered to volunteer several hours each week as a receptionist to help with Mass cards, phone calls, deliveries, etc. Join me in welcoming Sr. Joan to St. Luke Rectory and in thanking her for her service!

On this Third Sunday of Lent we turn to John's Gospel and find Jesus cleansing the Temple: "*Take these out of here, and stop making my Father's house a marketplace.*" Especially during Lent, we should make sure that our church is a House of Prayer. Many people are seeking the Lord and His mercy. Please help them to feel at home, and to find the quiet time they need to draw near to the Lord.

Grace Episcopal Church contacted me looking for assistance with their food pantry. They are in desperate need of non-perishable foods to replenish their shelves. In particular, they are looking for canned soup, canned vegetables, canned meat, canned fruit, boxed cereals, rice sides, and peanut butter. They accept donations Tuesday to Friday from 9 AM to 12 Noon. We will conduct a food drive on the weekend of March 16/17 to help them in their ministry, which provides at least 50 bags of food each week to a growing number of local families in need. Thank you in advance for your assistance and generosity.
