Laetare! Rejoice! Every year on the Fourth Sunday of Lent we have he option of using rose-colored vestments to show that we are well on our way to Easter, which is now just three weeks away. Today our gospel passage at Mass comes from the third chapter of John's gospel, including the famous John 3:16: "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life." Because we know that God loves us, we have every reason to rejoice, because our salvation s close at hand.

Next weekend, Bishop Chappetto will preach at all Masses and extend an invitation to the parish to join him in a Parish Mission,

which will take place on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday of that week. We have the custom of the Lenten Program on Tuesdays, and so we will have a full week of prayer and reflection just before Holy Week. Please spread the word to friends and neighbors from other parishes about our special Parish Mission week.

Last year I asked the art teacher in St. Luke School to work with the children in grades 2 to 8 to create images of the Stations of the Cross to be used on Good Friday. The students did a tremendous job, and they presented their artwork during a special Good Friday Stations of the Cross for children at noon. This year, I asked Mrs. Jones to have the children draw crucifixes using different styles of art. In addition, children in the school and the religious education program will write the reflections that will be used on Good Friday as we gather again with the parish children at noon to pray the Stations of the Cross. I hope this "new tradition" will help parents and children come together in prayer as we commemorate the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of the Lord each year.

Looking ahead to Holy Week ... Reconciliation Monday is Monday, March 25. In the bulletin you will see information about the schedules in the local parishes in our deanery. Here at St. Luke, priests are available after the noon Mass, and then in the evening from 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM. In the evening there will also be Eucharistic Adoration, with benediction being offered at 9:00 PM. On Tuesday of Holy Week at 4:30 PM, Bishop Brennan will celebrate the Chrism Mass at the Co-Cathedral of St. Joseph. If you can make your way there and wish to represent St. Luke, please let me know.

The Parish Council met recently, and they are trying to plan some "fun" events for our community, like Radio Bingo, a dance, beer and wine tasting, etc. Events like these help to build community and bring us together to enjoy one another's company. I hope we can get enough people to help organize these events, and then have a good response of parishioners who wish to participate. More information will follow as plans are made.
