

"Unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains just a grain of wheat; but if it dies, it produces much fruit." In the gospel for this fifth Sunday of Lent, Jesus tries to prepare his disciples for his death. Not only will they flee when Jesus faces His Passion, but they will need to be prepared to continue the ministry of Jesus after His Resurrection and Ascension. The death of Jesus produces much fruit. Many people come to know Him through the preaching and ministry of the Early Church, and through the ages by the example of women and men who dedicated their lives to the gospel. In these final weeks of Lent, may we re-commit ourselves to the Lord as we seek forgiveness for our sins.

As you know, Bishop Chappetto is a resident here at St. Luke, and he helps as a Sunday assistant and in many other ways. This weekend, he will preach at all Masses to invite everyone to a parish Lenten Mission that he will conduct this week. On Monday and Wednesday this week, Bishop Chappetto will lead a Holy Hour of prayer and reflection, and on Thursday the Mission will conclude with the celebration of Mass. The Holy Hours and Mass will begin at 7:00 PM on those nights, and all are welcome to attend and to invite neighbors and friends to join us for this special Lenten experience. On Tuesday evening, Sr. Laura Arvin, OP, will lead the final presentation for our regular weekly Lenten Program. We are grateful to all those who led our community in prayer this Lent, and we thank Sr. Theresa, Sr. Katherine, and Mary Pollini for all their work to find such wonderful speakers. Our Lent this year has been truly blessed!

This week we are conducting a Food Drive to help provide much-needed resources to the Food Pantry at Grace Episcopal Church. Many families in Whitestone turn to the Food Pantry to provide adequate meals for their families. I am grateful to the Knights of Columbus for their assistance in gathering the food and then delivering it for us.

I thank the Youth Group for sponsoring the Lenten Soup Supper last weekend. The young people did a wonderful job serving the soup and cleaning up, and it was a very enjoyable evening. I am grateful to the leaders of the Youth Group for their assistance in organizing and coordinating the event.

As we approach Holy Week, I hope that many parishioners will consider joining us during these special and holy days. The Triduum – Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday – are unique and beautiful celebrations. They are not holy days of obligation, but we celebrate the most profound mysteries of our faith as we recall the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of Jesus on those three days. Remember that Reconciliation Monday is Monday of Holy Week, March 25th. Remind your family members and neighbors of the special opportunity to be reconciled to the Lord on that day. *Repent and believe in the gospel!*

After a short service delay, it's nice to hear our bells swinging again! Thanks for your patience and your generosity!
