The Parish Council met this past week, and we were discussing some activities that are being considered/planned: a Mother's Day plant sale, Radio Bingo, 70's dance, Oktoberfest. We can use a few volunteers to help on Mother's Day weekend (May 11/12). Please contact the rectory if you can help. I'm glad that we are planning these kinds of events. I hope that we will get good responses from parishioners.

I brought up to the Parish Council that we need to look at our weekend Mass schedule. Last fall, Bishop Brennan raised the issue across the diocese, but Mass Books open in the fall and so it was not the right time for us to consider changing our Mass schedule. There are two practical considerations for us: 1) Msgr. Strynkowski is no

longer available to assist us, and I anticipate that Fr. JunHee Lee will no longer be available to assist us after the summer; we are grateful to Bishop Ray and Fr. Bill for their availability to assist us as senior priests in residence here at St. Luke; 2) with the exception of the 5 PM Sunday Mass, we have an identical Mass schedule to St. Mel. With only two priests officially assigned to the parish, we need to consider reducing our weekend Mass schedule. I hope that we can figure a way to get input from parishioners so that any proposed changes can be acceptable to the community.

The diocese asked if I would accept a seminarian for the summer. Juan Herrera is a classmate of Callistus, so, God willing, he will be ordained a deacon in November. He will arrive on May 13th and will be here at St. Luke through the middle of July. I am sure that you will welcome Juan, and that our parish will provide him with a good experience of pastoral ministry before he is ordained a deacon.

Next weekend will be busy: on Saturday there is the diocesan Eucharistic Revival celebration during the day at the Tennis Center in Flushing Meadows, and the St. Joseph Dinner Dance in the Pastoral Center in the evening. On Sunday, we will host a Blood Drive after all the morning Masses. I hope that many parishioners will take part in these events.

On Thursday this week we will welcome Bishop Massa to St. Luke as he confers the Sacrament of Confirmation on the young people of our parish. At Confirmation we are sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit to help us serve one another in love. We pray for Bishop Massa, the young people to be confirmed, and their parents and sponsors, that all of us will be renewed in our faith as the confirmandi are fully initiated as Catholics.

On this third Sunday of Easter, St. Luke tells what happened after the disciples encountered Jesus on the road to Emmaus. The gift of peace is so important to the Risen Christ; over and over again He says, "Peace be with you," as He encounters the apostles and disciples. Jesus also extends the gift of peace to us, especially through the Sacrament of Penance. How do we accept that gift of peace? How do we live the gift of peace? We ask Jesus to help us to be ambassadors of His love and peace as we live our lives as His disciples. We pray especially that parents and grandparents and sponsors can be the best of examples to our young people.
