Our nation has been through a very difficult period with the assassination attempt on former President Trump. We pray for the family of Corey Comperatore, the man who was killed while protecting his family, and for the two other victims, David Dutch and James Copenhaver, who were both injured and are recovering. Clearly, our nation is divided politically. We need to pray that our differences can be dealt with through respectful discourse and debate instead of vitriol and hatred. One of the reports I saw about the shooter is that he was a loner and was bullied regularly in high school. Bullying goes beyond normal teasing. There are too many stories of young people either committing suicide or causing harm to others because of enduring

endless harassment in the schoolyard or on social media. In my experience, sometimes children learn to bully in the family. Over my years of ministry, parish staff members have had to deal with verbal harassment and abuse from parents and other adults who disagreed with policies or procedures in the school or the parish. Perhaps the events of the past week will encourage frank conversations among all of us, particularly between parents and children. Ask your children if they have been bullied. Also, ask your children if they have bullied others, even on social media. A great video on YouTube that can be a great conversation-starter is "Bully Talk - with Nick Vujicic." Nick was born with no arms and no legs. Doctors said he would never walk, but he has become a great man of faith and a motivational speaker. He was bullied as a child and almost committed suicide, but he found strength in God and has become an inspiration to others. I have included a link to the video on our parish's Facebook page. I encourage you to watch it alone or as a family, and then talk about how harmful bullying can be. I believe that with God's grace, good can follow evil. It happens all the time.

There are wonderful feasts of saints this week. On Monday, July 22nd, we celebrate the Feast of St. Mary Magdalene. Scriptures tell us that Jesus cast seven demons out of her when he met her. Sometimes she is thought to have been a prostitute, or the woman who washes the feet of Jesus with her tears and dries them with her hair, but the Scriptures don't explicitly identify her in this way. More important is that she became a faithful follower of Jesus and was on Calvary for the crucifixion. She was also one of the first witnesses of the resurrection of Jesus. Mary Magdalene is the patroness of converts, repentant sinners, sexual temptation, pharmacists, tanners, and women. On Thursday, July 25th, we celebrate the Feast of St. James, the Apostle. James was the brother of John, the Beloved Disciple, and was traditionally the first apostle to be martyred by being beheaded by King Herod. Our diocesan Cathedral is dedicated to St. James, and so he is a special patron of Brooklyn and Queens. On Friday, July 26th, we celebrate the Memorial of Saints Joachim and Anne, the parents of Mary, and so the grandparents of Jesus. In recent years, Pope Francis has encouraged the faithful to celebrate their feast by honoring grandparents and all seniors who live among us. We pray that the intercession of St. Mary Magdalene, St. James and Saints Joachim and Anne will help all of us to remain close to the Lord.

It is good to have Fr. Chin back from Vietnam. I will now take some time for vacation, and then Fr. Chin will go away again later in August. I pray that all of us may enjoy time for family and relaxation during these summer days.





Feast of SAINT MARY MAGDALENE


According to the four Gospels of the Bible, Mary Magdalene was a follower of Jesus who witnessed His crucifixion, burial, and resurrection.

It is mentioned in the Gospels of Luke and Mark that Jesus exorcised seven demons from her.


In 2016, Pope Francis raised the level of liturgical memory on July 22 from memorial to feast and for her to be referred to as the "Apostolorum Apostola" ("Apostle of the Apostles").

Preaching about St. Mary Magdalene, Pope Francis highlighted Christ's mercy toward a woman who was "exploited and despised by those who believed they were righteous," but she was loved and forgiven by him.

Her tears at Christ's empty tomb are a reminder that "sometimes in our lives, tears are the lenses we need to see Jesus," the pope said April 2, 2013, during Mass in his residence, the Domus Sanctae Marthae.
