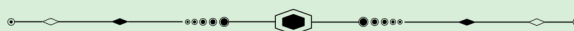

In the Catholic Church, the Sunday readings are organized over a three-year cycle – A, B & C. In this way, the faithful are given the opportunity to hear a major portion of the Scriptures over three years. During Year A, we mostly hear from the Gospel of St. Matthew; in Year B, from St. Mark; and in Year C, our patron, St. Luke. We are currently in Year B, and so we have heard a good deal from Mark’s Gospel, which is thought to be the oldest Gospel. It is also the shortest Gospel, with only 16 chapters. Since it is so short, the Church adds the sixth chapter of John’s gospel from the 17<sup>th</sup> to the 21<sup>st</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time. John 6:22-59 is known as *The Bread of Life Discourse*. While John’s Gospel

records the Last Supper, including Jesus washing the feet of his disciples and the High Priestly Prayer of Jesus, it does not include the narrative regarding the institution of the Eucharist: *This is my Body; This is my Blood.*” Instead, the 6<sup>th</sup> chapter is given to provide a deeper explanation of the Eucharist: “Jesus said to them, ‘Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day (John 6:53-54).’” So beginning today and through the month of August we will have the opportunity to reflect on the great gift of the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. What a wonderful way to extend the graces and blessing of the Eucharistic Congress and this year of Eucharistic Revival!

On Monday, July 29, we celebrate the Memorial of Saints Martha, Mary and Lazarus. Up until three years ago, this was known as the Memorial of St. Martha, but Pope Francis extended the Memorial to include all three siblings who were dear friends of Jesus. There are two references to Jesus visiting Martha, Mary and Lazarus at their home in Bethany. During the first visit, Martha was busy showing hospitality to her guests while Mary chose the better part by sitting at the feet of Jesus and listening to him preach. The second visit took place just before Jesus entered Jerusalem for the final time. Lazarus died, and Jesus came to mourn with Mary and Martha. Then, he asked to be brought to the tomb, and after directing the people to roll the stone away, Jesus called Lazarus back to life, and Lazarus walked out of the tomb. These siblings are a holy family and are counted among the dear friends of Jesus.

Friday this week is the First Friday of August. After the noon Mass, the Eucharist will be exposed on the altar, and confessions will be available until benediction at 2:00 PM. Spending time with Jesus in the Eucharist is a privilege and a gift. We hope to provide other opportunities for adoration on weeknights over the summer. Don’t forget that every Saturday during confessions from 3:30 to 4:30 PM we have Eucharistic Adoration and Benediction. Parish communities are truly blessed when parishioners make the effort to spend some quite time with the Lord in prayer. May Jesus bless St. Luke Parish!

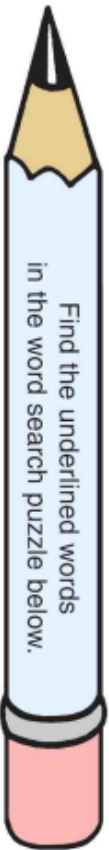
