By now, most parishioners have taken down the Christmas decorations, but the Church continues to celebrate the season through this weekend. The liturgical season of Christmas ends with the celebration of the Baptism of the Lord. Although this event takes place some 30 years after the Nativity, it marks the end of his private life and the beginning of his public ministry. Moreover, the Church traditionally links three events in the life of Jesus: the Epiphany, the Baptism of the Lord, and the miracle at the wedding feast of Cana. The antiphon for the Canticle at Morning Prayer for the Epiphany illustrates the point: *Today the Bridegroom claims his bride, the Church, since Christ has washed her sins away in Jordan's waters; the Magi hasten with their gifts to the royal wedding; and the wedding guests rejoice, for Christ has changed water into wine, alleluia.* Our celebrations at this time of year are so rich with meaning and inspiration. May the Lord bless us abundantly as we bring the Christmas season to an end.

On Friday we celebrate St. Anthony the Abbot. Anthony was an Egyptian Christian who lived a very austere life in the desert. When he was about 18 his parents died, leaving him land and the responsibility for a young sister. Hearing Matthew 19:21 read in church, he decided to rid himself of his possessions to follow Jesus, but he kept just enough to care for his sister. Then, he heard Matthew 6:34: "Do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will bring worries of its own." He therefore gave away everything else and entrusted his sister to a convent so he could live a life of prayer and fasting. He was eager to learn from others, and after encountering examples of holiness in the lives of others, he would seek to imitate them to improve his own life as a disciple. People would venture out into the desert to talk to him and to be healed by him, but he refused to come out. Though he wanted to live a solitary life, people eventually broke his door down, and so he would speak to them, heal them, and comfort them. Anthony died at 105 years of age. He never stopped challenging himself to go one step beyond in his faith.

We had a parish truck/plow for about 20 years, and it officially "died" before the holidays. We purchased a new truck this weekend. If you are in a position to make an extra donation to help offset the cost of the new truck, the parish budget will be very grateful!

On behalf of the clergy and staff of the parish, I want to thank all those who dropped off gifts, baked goods and other treats for us at Christmas. We try to acknowledge gifts personally, but sometimes we don't have enough information to individually show our appreciation. In so many ways, people show how truly blessed we are. May God bless you and reward you for your goodness.



