This is our last full week before Lent. With such a late Easter, we have had “extra time” this year to give some thought and prayer to how we will spend the 40 days. What will I give up? What charitable work will I try to do? During our Easter Vigil this year there will be several people who will be received into the Church and celebrate the Sacraments of Initiation here at St. Luke. We pray for all those who are seeking the Lord, that they may find in our parish a community of believers who welcome them as we strive to be faithful disciples who journey together to the kingdom.

This week the children of St. Luke School preparing for First Holy Communion will celebrate the Sacrament of Penance. What a great gift it is to receive God’s mercy and forgiveness when we humble ourselves, admit our sins, and seek reconciliation. The children in our Religious Education Program will receive the sacrament early next month. For the sake of everyone who may wish to celebrate the sacrament between now and Easter, here is an Act of Contrition:

O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended Thee,
and I detest all my sins because of thy just punishments,
but most of all because they offend Thee, my God,
who art all good and deserving of all my love.
I firmly resolve with the help of Thy grace
to sin no more and to avoid the near occasion of sin. Amen.

For those who come to the Reconciliation Room to celebrate the Sacrament of Penance, don’t worry ... we provide a sheet with several versions of the Act of Contrition so you don’t need to be concerned about having it memorized. We priests are always happy to help penitents who have been away from the sacrament for a while ... just cross the threshold and we will guide you from beginning to end.

Our passage from Luke’s gospel this weekend is quite a challenge: love your enemies and do good to them, and lend expecting nothing back; then your reward will be great. Sometimes it’s hard enough to love those who love us! Jesus’ command to not only love our enemies, but also to do good to them, is not easy! However, we look to the gift of love from Jesus on the cross and we realize that He always teaches by example. Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful.

Just a reminder ... Symbolon will return next Saturday after the 8:30 AM Mass. We have a core group who have been attending, but anyone is welcome to join us. I encourage you to take the opportunity to join others as we learn more about our Catholic faith.
