As I write this, the Cardinals are about to enter the Conclave to elect a new Pope. I presume that as we gather for worship this weekend, a new Pope will have been elected. Whoever he is, we certainly thank God for his willingness to accept the responsibility of being the Vicar of Christ on earth. After a Cardinal is elected Pope, he enters the “Room of Tears” to prepare himself to be presented to the world as the new Holy Father by changing into the white cassock before he comes out on the loggia of St. Peter’s Basilica to give his first blessing to the city and to the world. I can’t imagine what those first private moments are like. It must be overwhelming as he comes to grips with the fact that his life is no longer

his own, and that he will spend the rest of his days as the spiritual leader of over 1.4 billion Catholics around the world. Please be patient with us priests as we try to remember to say the correct name when we pray for the Pope in the Eucharistic Prayer! Above all, we unite with all Catholics around the world as we pray for our new Pope.

I hope that one of the priorities of the Holy Father will be to set a date for the canonization of Carlo Acutis. The canonization was to have taken place on Divine Mercy Sunday, but due to the death of Pope Francis the canonization was postponed. There is something special about soon having a saint who wore khakis, carried a cell phone, enjoyed video games, and developed a website to promote Eucharistic miracles from around the world. I pray that all parishioners, especially teenagers, will foster a devotion to him as a role model in living the faith in the third Christian millennium.

This weekend the children of our religious education program received Holy Communion for the first time, so all our parish children have now received their sacraments for this pastoral year. We pray for our young people, that they may continue to deepen their relationship with Jesus by receiving the Eucharist each weekend. May our newly confirmed young people remember that they have been sealed with the Gifts of the Holy Spirit and can make use of those gifts to avoid falling into sin and instead remain in God’s grace as they follow the path that the Lord has set for them.

On this Fourth Sunday of Easter we join the Church in celebrating Good Shepherd Sunday, a traditional day to pray in a special way for vocations to the priesthood. Jesus said, “My sheep hear my voice.” Of course, we hear the voice of Jesus in the Sacred Scriptures, whether we read the Bible on our own or hear the Word proclaimed when we gather for worship. We also hear the voice of Jesus in prayer. Our prayer is incomplete if we simply bring our prayers of petition to the Lord and then walk away. Instead, we need to foster some quiet time with the Lord so He can respond to our prayers. Our parish has been blessed with many vocations over the years. May the young men of St. Luke open their hearts to the possibility of serving the Lord as a priest. As I prepare to celebrate my 36th anniversary next month, I thank God every day for the privilege of serving Him by serving you as your priest and pastor. It is not always easy, but I recognize countless blessings in my priestly ministry, and I would certainly encourage others to discern the Lord’s call.


Collective Intentions Mass
