

Of course, this federal holiday gives us a chance to honor and remember those who made the ultimate sacrifice in the service of our country. Gold star mothers and fathers and other family members carry the burden of the death of their loved ones, and so we express our love and support of them on Memorial Day, too. We will celebrate Mass on Memorial Day at 9:30 AM to remember all of them, and our Whitestone community will hold a ceremony and parade beginning at

11:00 AM at the field on 149th Street and 15th Drive. All are welcome!

Last weekend our parish hosted an Eagle Scout Court of Honor for two young men in Troop 235.
