The Easter season comes to an end with the celebration of Pentecost. For 50 days we have rejoiced at the resurrection of Jesus from the dead; 10 days ago we recalled his Ascension to the Father and the promise of the Spirit. Now, we are renewed in God's Holy Spirit, the Paraclete. We return to Ordinary Time on Monday, but the next two Sundays are special celebrations for the Church: the Most Holy Trinity next weekend, and then the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ on the following weekend. All these celebrations and solemnities remind us of the powerful love of God that sustains the Church and helps all

of us remain faithful disciples.

This year we have one adult to be confirmed at Pentecost. Anthony Kelly has been working with Sr. Katherine in preparation of receiving the Sacrament today. We pray for him and for all those who will be sealed with the Gifts of the Holy Spirit around the world, that they may faithfully practice their faith and give witness to the hope and mercy of Jesus in their daily lives.

We certainly had a wonderful return of the St. Luke Carnival last weekend! Clearly Msgr. Tosi and Sal Colak were looking down on us on those days. There was a threat of some rain but we were spared, although it was certainly a little chilly, especially on Saturday evening! Sabato Daniele and John Dierks worked so hard together with dozens of volunteers to make the Carnival such a great success. On Sunday morning we had just over \$14,000 for the 50/50 raffle. When we pulled the winning ticket at 9:30 PM, we hit the highest 50/50 total in Carnival history: \$26,020! We will soon give a full report of the proceeds, but I am truly grateful to everyone who made an effort to allow for such a great return to the St. Luke Carnival.

St. Luke School Class of 2025 will graduate this week. On Thursday we will celebrate a Baccalaureate Mass, and then the actual Graduation Ceremony will take place on Friday. We pray for our graduates, that the foundation of faith and knowledge that was provided to them here will continue to bear fruit as they move onto high school and beyond. We are grateful to the parents for the sacrifices they made to send their children to a Catholic School. Of course, we are equally grateful to the faculty and staff of our school. Their commitment and dedication, along with their own personal sacrifices to teach in a Catholic School, are a great witness to the faith and values that are the hallmark of a Catholic School. The last day of school for the rest of the students will be Tuesday, June 24th.

On Saturday, June 21st at 11:00 AM there will be a street re-naming at Parsons Boulevard and 25th Road in memory of Antonella Mattina. Antonella was just 12 years old when she was abducted on July 16, 1984. Her remains were found three years later on Thanksgiving Day, and her case was never solved. Her parents are parishioners here at St. Luke. Please plan to join with the family to remember Antonella and to support her family and loved ones.
