Today the Church celebrates the Most Holy Trinity. One of the first prayers we learn is to make the Sign of the Cross, and so from a very young age we are exposed to the great mystery of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. We are reminded that we believe in one God Who is manifested in three divine Persons. The Mystery of the Holy Trinity is a mystery of love. The love between the Father and the Son is poured out through the Holy Spirit, and the love of our Triune God is poured out among us as disciples of the Lord, as we hear in the second reading today from Paul’s letter to the Romans: “the love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the

Holy Spirit that has been given to us.”

Today is also Father’s Day, so we will celebrate our fathers, grandfathers, godfathers, and all those men who have served as father-figures where a father has been absent in the lives of others. We priests have the privilege of being called “fathers” in our parish communities, and hopefully we faithfully respond to that responsibility with the proper balance of love, support, and paternal challenges to bring all of us closer to Jesus. On behalf of the clergy and staff of the parish, I wish all of these men a very Happy Father’s Day!

As you know, at the end of the month, there will be a new “father” among us ... Deacon Callistus Ibeh will be ordained a priest of the Diocese of Brooklyn on Saturday, June 28th at the Co-Cathedral of St. Joseph. On Sunday, June 29th, he will return to St. Luke to celebrate a Mass of Thanksgiving at 12:00 PM. Afterwards, the Martha’s Ministry will provide a reception for all those attending. If you’d like to help offset the cost of the reception, please write “reception” on an envelope and leave it either at the rectory or in the collection basket next week. Also, if you can’t be here on that day but wish to leave a card or gift for Fr. Callistus, you can bring it to the rectory, and we will make sure he receives it. Deacon Juan Herrera will also be ordained; we hope to have him return in the fall to celebrate a Mass among us so we can offer our best wishes to him as he begins his priestly ministry.

Thursday, June 19th, is Juneteenth, a day that celebrates the end of slavery in our country. It is a federal holiday, so the rectory office will be closed, and Mass will be celebrated at 9:30 AM. There will be no noon Mass on Thursday. Also, since the school year is winding down, there will be no more 8:30 AM Masses on Tuesdays and Thursdays until school reopens in September.

Early voting is taking place in the Monsignor Tosi Pastoral Center through next Sunday, June 22nd. Voting hours are: June 14-16 from 9 AM to 5 PM; June 17 & 18 from 10 AM to 8 PM; June 19 from 9 AM to 5 PM; June 20 from 8 AM to 4 PM; June 21 & 22 from 9 AM to 5 PM. No parish activities can take place in the Pastoral Center on those days. Thank you for your patience and understanding.


