Today the Church celebrates the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, formerly known as Corpus Christi. While other Christians see the bread and wine as a symbol or sign, Catholics believe that the Eucharist is the Real Presence of Jesus: Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity. The ordinary sign of reverence before the Eucharist, whether it is on the altar or in the tabernacle, is a genuflection (as we age and the knees don't allow a proper genuflection, a profound bow is an acceptable substitute). A long tradition in the Church is to celebrate this solemnity with a Eucharistic procession, which allows us to bring our faith out into the streets of our local

community. Whenever we receive the Body and Blood of Jesus, we are to become more like the One we receive: more merciful, more charitable, more kind, more patient, more thankful.

When it comes to receiving the Eucharist, there are two options: either the host is placed on the palm of our hand, or directly onto the tongue. If you choose to receive the host in your hand, place your dominant hand flat under your other hand to form a "throne" upon which the host may be placed. You immediately are to take the host with your dominant hand and place the host in your mouth as you step aside and return to your place. If you choose to receive on the tongue, it is important that you extend the tongue straight out so that the priest or minister can easily place it on your tongue. You should not grab the host from the priest or minister; nor should you keep your tongue in your mouth or extend it downwards towards the floor. It is important to make it easy for the priest or minister to place the host in your hand or on your tongue reverently so that it does not fall to the ground accidentally. When the priest or minister says, "The Body of Christ," the proper response is, "Amen!"

Summer officially arrived on Friday, and it looks like the summer heat has finally arrived, too. Please remember that our Mass schedule will change as of July 1st. All of our weekend Masses will be on the half hour: Saturday at 4:30 PM, Sunday at 8:30 AM (Italian/English), 10:30 AM and 12:30 PM. During the summer there will be no Sunday evening Mass, but when it returns after Labor Day, it will be at 4:30 PM. You can find a notice of the new Mass schedule here and at St. Mel in the bulletin.

I am happy to announce that a seminarian will be in residence here beginning July 1st. Patrice Legoute grew up in Queens Village and just finished his pastoral year at St. Sebastian Parish in Woodside. He will work for a Jesuit-run program called Thrive for Life to assist prisoners with an education so they can successfully re-integrate back into society. While his ministry here at St. Luke will be limited, he will live in the rectory and help out around the parish from time to time. I am sure that you will welcome Patrice and encourage him as he continues his formation for priesthood in the Diocese of Brooklyn.






Stop Physician-Assisted Suicide in New York

New York is on the brink of legalizing physician-assisted suicide. Bill A136 has already passed the Senate and Assembly. The only thing standing in its way is Governor Hochul's veto – and she needs to hear from you.
