I will be away for most of the month of July. I am currently visiting a seminary classmate at Lake Winnepesaukee in New Hampshire. We have known one another for 40 years, and so I am looking forward to enjoying time with him. Fr. Chin is not alone ... Bishop Chappetto and Fr. Krlis will be around for most of the month. We are blessed that they are able to help us!

We haven't had an Ordinary Time Sunday since before Lent! On this 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time, Jesus appoints 72 disciples to go ahead of him in pairs to prepare the way for him. "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest." Typically, the Church sees this verse as an encouragement from Jesus to pray for vocations. While prayer is important, I think another important element to fostering vocations is an invitation. I know for myself that if a priest did not ask me about becoming a priest when I was in high school, I would likely not be your pastor today! By the way, my assignment here at St. Luke is now officially my longest assignment as a priest. I began my assignment here on July 1, 2020, and I have not had an assignment that lasted longer than five years. I pray that God will bless me with many more happy years as your pastor.

At the beginning of June, Pope Leo XIV sent a message to participants in the seminar "Evangelizing with the Families of Today and Tomorrow: Ecclesiological and Pastoral Challenges," organized by the Dicastery for Laity, Family and Life. He concluded his message in this way:

Do not be discouraged by the difficult situations you face. It is true that families today have many problems, but "the Gospel of the family also nourishes seeds that are still waiting to grow, and serves as the basis for caring for those plants that are wilting and must not be neglected" (FRANCIS, *Amoris Laetitia*, 76).

What great need there is to promote an encounter with God, whose tender love values and loves the story of every person! It is not a matter of giving hasty answers to difficult questions, but of drawing close to people, listening to them, and trying to understand together with them how to face their difficulties. And this requires a readiness to be open, when necessary, to new ways of seeing things and different ways of acting, for each generation is different and has its own challenges, dreams and questions. Yet amid all these changes, Jesus Christ remains "the same yesterday and today and forever" (Heb 13:8). Consequently, if we want to help families experience joyful paths of communion and be seeds of faith for one another, we must first cultivate and renew our own identity as believers.

Dear brothers and sisters, thank you for what you do! May the Holy Spirit guide you in discerning criteria and methods that support and promote the Church's efforts to minister to families. Let us help families to listen courageously to Christ's proposal and the Church's words of encouragement! I will remember you in my prayers, and I cordially impart to all of you my Apostolic Blessing.




# Stop Physician-Assisted Suicide in New York
