I hope that everyone is doing well and enjoying the summer despite the heat! Fr. Chin will be gone for most of August, and Fr. Bill will be away as well. Bishop Chappetto and I will be here to hold down the fort! Next weekend we will have the annual mission appeal for the Propagation of the Faith. Bishop DiMarzio will be here to speak on behalf of the Diocese of Our Lady of Deliverance of the Syrian Eparchy. There are no envelopes for this collection, so baskets will go through the church a second time next weekend so we can generously

contribute to their work of evangelization.

Since the weather report looks good, we will have Eucharistic Adoration by the Marian grotto behind the rectory tomorrow evening. August 4th is the feast of St. John Marie Vianney, the patron saint of priests, so we will use the opportunity to pray in a special way for vocations. Folding chairs will be available, but you are welcome to bring your own seat if you'd like. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed at 7 PM, and Benediction will take place at 9 PM. Over my years here, these have been wonderful and prayerful evenings to spend some time with the Lord. All are welcome!

I am always looking for ideas from other parish bulletins or on social media. I recently saw a parish looking for donors to “adopt a classroom” to help teachers create a helpful learning environment for students. As you know, Catholic school teachers are paid far less than their counterparts in the public schools, and teachers often use their own money to provide decorations and supplies for their classrooms. You can be sure that St. Luke School teachers would appreciate financial reimbursement to help them as they begin to set up for a new academic year. The gospel this weekend reminds us of the importance of keeping our focus on our true treasure in heaven. While we enjoy and need the benefits of this world, we can’t take them with us! The rich man in the parable thought first of building bigger barns instead of sharing his bounty with others. Little did he know that God had other plans. Jesus exhorts us not to be fools, but to make ourselves rich in what matters to God.

Every year on August 6th the Church celebrates the Transfiguration of the Lord. Peter, James and John accompany Jesus up Mount Tabor, and they witness this great event as Moses and Elijah appear with Jesus as a sign of God’s plan: Jesus has come to fulfill the Law and the Prophets. The Transfiguration happens in the midst of Jesus’ prayer, and the voice of the Father announces: “This is my chosen Son; listen to him.” When we pray, we need to open our hearts to the voice of God, who responds to us whenever we place ourselves in His loving presence. As we listen to God in prayer, we can then follow His plan for us more closely, to be the faithful disciples we are called to be. Listen and live!

I hope you enjoyed Pope Leo XIV’s reflections during the month of July. I thought it would be a good opportunity to help you be inspired by our new Holy Father.
